

Timeline for Creating a 4-Day Week Calendar

January 16, 2025 – During the school board meeting, the board requested that surveys be conducted to gauge interest in a potential 4-day school week.

February 2-9, 2025 – Surveys were distributed to students (grades 7-11), parents, and staff to gather feedback.

February 20, 2025 – The overwhelmingly positive survey results were shared with the school board, which decided to proceed with the development of a 4-day calendar.

February 21, 2025 – Survey results were made available to the public via the district website.

March 4, 2025 – A staff calendar committee was formed, with all staff members invited to participate. The committee held its first meeting to begin discussing calendar options.

March 6, 2025 – A student advisory group, composed of students in grades 7-10, met with the principal and superintendent to provide feedback and ask questions.

March 6, 2025 – A parent meeting was held in the cafeteria to present information, gather feedback, and address questions regarding the 4-day calendar proposal.

March 7, 2025 – A virtual meeting of the staff calendar committee was held to specifically address a parent concern about start and end times under the proposed 4-day week.

March 17-19, 2025 – Staff members voted on three proposed calendar options. The calendar receiving the majority of votes was selected.

March 20, 2025 – The staff-selected calendar will be presented to the school board for final approval.

Throughout this process, the superintendent, principal, and staff calendar committee remained available to address questions and concerns via phone, email, and in-person meetings.
