There was an update and discussion regarding the 2022-2023 SCS Spending Plan and the Minimum Budget Requirement.

Superintendent Carter shared a document which reviewed the spending plan and how the Board of Education arrived at the amount to send to the Board of Finance for their approval.

Motion by Anne Vance/2nd by Kitty Visconti to request that the Sharon Board of Finance call a Town Meeting for the purpose of requesting that \$117,629 additional funds be added to the Sharon Center School budget for the 2022-2023 school year, with the expectation that these additional funds will be returned to the Town.
