Sharon Center School Board of Education

The regular meeting was held on Monday, March 14, 2022 in the school library.

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 P.M. by Chair Doug Cahill.

Motion carried by unanimous vote.*

Motion by Monica Connor/2nd by Deborah Rathbun to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

No public comment was heard.

As March is Board Appreciation Month, the Board Members were honored.

Principal Manning honored and thanked Leslie Klish and Bruce Adam for their dedication and commitment to their computer and IT work, which keeps the school running smoothly.

Principal Manning reviewed Winter Fastbridge and explained how to interpret the data.

Principal Manning gave a Power Point presentation highlighting some of the activities and programs at the school recently.

8th grade graduation is scheduled for Tuesday, June 14.

June 16 is expected to be the last day of school for students.

The air conditioning project has an anticipated completion date in April.

Principal Manning reviewed the Extended Days/Enrichment Survey, to which 30 families responded.

She also updated the Board as to the planned day trips planned for the 8th grade students.

Scott Fellows and Jill Pace reviewed the Assistant Superintendents' report, highlighting the planned Regional Summer Program, for which they are hoping to receive a grant to cover transportation costs.

A revamped version of the Grade 4 Arts Day is also planned for the week of April 11th.

Principal Manning read letters from four families, requesting that their children be permitted to attend Sharon Center School during the 2022-2023 school year.

Motion by Monica Connor/2nd by Deborah Rathbun to approve all four enrollment requests. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Principal Manning read a letter from Debbie Anderson, cafeteria assistant, informing the Board that she planned to retire, effective at the end of the school year.

Motion by Amanda Thompson/2nd by Anne Vance to accept, with regret, her letter of retirement. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Motion by Monica Connor/2nd by Kathleen Visconti to post this position with an hourly rate of \$17.50. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Motion by Amanda Thompson/2nd by Monica Connor to approve 6 professional development days for Sharon Center School, with a 12:10 dismissal time for students. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Motion by Anne Vance/2nd by Deborah Rathbun to continue with the current tuition rates for out of district students for the 2022-2023 school year:

\$2,200 for 1st child

\$2,000 for 2nd child

\$1,800 for 3rd child

Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Motion by Amanda Thompson/2nd by Deborah Rathbun to table the Region-Wide Policies that were scheduled for a Second Reading until the April Meeting, and to have the Policy Committee review those policies again. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

There was a First Reading of Policies and Regulations from the 5000 series. There were no comments or questions on any of these policies.
