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Temporary License Plates Reminder

Previously owned vehicles sold by licensed California dealers that already have permanent California license plates **do not** require the issuance of Temporary License Plates (TLP), even if the registration has expired. Vehicles displaying the required number of permanent California license plates with an expired sticker can be operated with the purchaser's temporary identification copy (the bottom portion of the Report of Sale form) affixed to vehicle's windshield or a side window up to 90 days from the date of sale.

TLPs are only required to be issued and affixed to a previously owned vehicle when the vehicle is missing one or both permanent license plates.
