


Navigating the Zearn Platform


Preview our comprehensive suite of digital and print materials designed to support teachers with planning daily instruction that meets the needs of every student.

This view is only for teachers and administrators.


Students will login and get right to working on digital lessons. See firsthand what your students will experience by clicking "View student feed."

 - Click "Materials in Spanish" to view all available Spanish-language materials for every Mission of the grade.






Explore every component of the Zearn Math Teacher Materials from each Mission page.

Fluency Activities

Individually adaptive and lesson-aligned activities help students develop the foundations for new learning.

Guided Practice

Students explore new math concepts with built-in learning acceleration supports, including scaffolded access points that help students engage with new grade-level ideas.

Independent Practice

A daily formative assessment checks for understanding and launches adaptive supports that bring connected foundational concepts right into the context of grade-level learning.



- Class reports help teachers track students' progress to completing 3+ lessons each week and provide real-time alerts when students need more support.
- Student reports give teachers insight into each student's precise learning needs.
