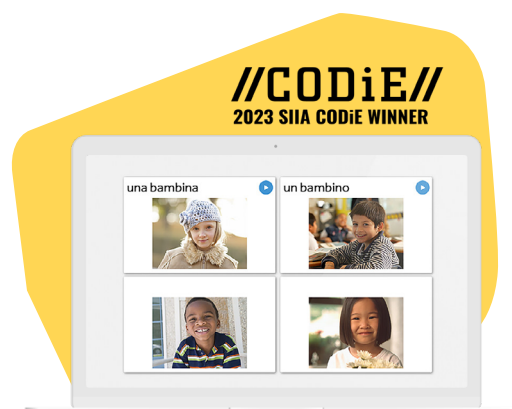

In a randomized controlled trial (Harper et al., 2021), English Learners who used Rosetta Stone as part of their language instruction demonstrated greater gains on their Speaking-Listening and Reading Aloud scores on the TELL (Test of English Language Learning) compared to peers who did not use Rosetta Stone.
