Q: What is the Extended School Year (ESY) 2025 program dates? A: ESY 2025 Program dates are from Tuesday, June **17th** through Wednesday, July **16th**.

Q: What are the ESY 2025 student school site hours?

A: ESY 2025 student school site hours are as follows:

Elementary Schools:

- Monday through Friday 8:00am-12:20pm.*

Middle Schools:

-Monday through Friday 8:00am-12:00pm.*

High Schools and Special Education Centers:

- Monday through Friday 8:30am-12:50pm.*

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Q: How will students participate in the ESY program?

A: The Instructional Model will be in-person at the designated sites. However, students currently enrolled in Virtual Academy are eligible to attend either virtually or in-person. Please visit the <u>ESY Parent Website</u> for updated information.

Q: How are the students selected for ESY sites?

A: The ESY site is based on your child's school of attendance. Please visit the Special Education <u>ESY 2025 School Listing</u> on the <u>ESY Parent Website</u> to identify your child's ESY site using their current school of attendance (RSY).

Q: Can parents/guardians update their child's current/residential address using the Parent Portal?

A: No. Addresses and emergency contacts must be updated at the student's current school of attendance with proof of residence.

Q: For High School students only: Does my student receive course credit for attending ESY? What are the other summer session options?
A: Yes, students can earn elective credits for attending ESY. These credits do not apply to A-G requirements. For credit recovery options please consult with your child's HS academic counselor. For other summer session options refer to Summer 2025 Programs Website.

Q: My child is eligible for ESY, can they attend both ESY and a summer program?

A: Yes, as long as dates and times do not overlap. Students can enroll for ESY until July **16^{th,}** the last day of ESY Instruction.

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Q: When will the parents/guardians be notified of ESY registration?

A: Schools will begin notifying parents/guardians the week of March **31**st. All students enrolled in ESY, as of May **23**rd, will receive a Welcome Letter prior to ESY via US Mail.

Q: How do parents/guardians confirm enrollment in ESY?

A: These are the ways parents/guardians can confirm their child's enrollment for ESY:

- 1. Parents/guardians can go on the <u>Parent Portal</u> to confirm by June **3**rd

- 2. Parents/guardians can also contact their child's school of attendance to assist with ESY enrollment by June **10th**

After June **10th**, if registering a student during the late enrollment process, parents/guardians have the following options

- 1. Sign, scan, and email the ESY Parent Confirmation Letter to <u>spedsfss@lausd.net</u>.
- 2. Sign and fax the ESY Parent Confirmation to: (877) 339-2684
- Contact the School and Family Support Services Call Center for assistance with enrolling via phone at 213-241-6701, Monday-Friday 7:00AM to 5:00PM
- 4. Confirm, in person, at the ESY Site beginning on June 17th

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Q: After completing the ESY Parent Confirmation Letter on the ESY Parent Portal, what do the different statuses mean?

A: Once an application is complete, there are several different statuses that may appear.

- **ACTIVE** indicates that you have confirmed that your student will attend ESY.
- **DISCHARGE** indicates that you have confirmed that your student will not attend ESY.
- **NO RESPONSE** indicates you have yet to respond to your student's ESY application.
- **PENDING** indicates that your student's application has been accepted for ESY and is in process.

Q: When is the last day I can confirm and enroll my child in ESY? A: The Parent Portal will close on June **3rd**. Students can still enroll in person for ESY at their indicated <u>ESY site</u> starting June **17**th until July **16**th.

Q: Will my child receive related services during ESY?

A: ESY related services are implemented as prescribed on student's active Individualized Education Program (IEP).

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
