

Assistive Technology Lending Libraries



Regional ATLL

The Instructional Technology and Assistive Technology Program, through the support of the Division of Special Education, established the Assistive Technology Lending Libraries (ATLL) for teachers, administrators, and Related Services providers to have access to a wide range of assistive technology supports. The seven regional ATLLs are situated throughout the Los Angeles Unified School District to provide easy access for all.

Access for Learning

The Assistive Technology Lending Libraries (ATLL) offer the best of research-based assistive technology to support student success in learning. Multi-disciplinary team members connect through the ATLL to collaborate for device trials for students. The power of Universal Design for Learning (UDL) is supported through the resources of the ATLL, including professional development and short-term device loans.

Access for Collaboration

The District's Assistive Technology (AT) Assessors can be contacted through the Assistive Technology Lending Library (ATLL), providing a pathway to explore supports for students. The students' needs may be addressed through the Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) collaboration or an IEP team decision based on an assessment. The goal is to provide the student quick access to support through short-term trials of the assistive technology resources at the ATLL.



Access Innovative Technology

Resources at the Assistive Technology Lending Library (ATLL) range from no tech and low tech through complex technology and incorporate the latest innovative technology. If a student has extensive access needs, the ATLL can support school site teams with devices to explore innovative pathways for learning. Current innovative technology resources include eye gaze devices, specialized switches, and telerobots when a student's physical condition prevents them from attending school on campus. The decision on assistive technology is determined by the IEP team.

Teachers are encouraged to connect with the ATLL staff for trial use of technology to support students within their classrooms. Long-term device access needs are to be addressed by the schools and IEP team decisions. Visits at the ATLL are through appointments only.
