



No schools or structures were damaged.

Concerns regarding smoke, air quality, and possible contaminant deposition.



LAUSD sampled **10 schools within 3 miles** of the fire.

Monitoring was conducted during & after the fire & will continue until the Lineage site is cleaned.



SAMPLING CONDUCTED

- Collected indoor/outdoor air and dust wipes (high-touched surfaces)
- Soil (unpaved areas & gardens)

AIR SAMPLES



Hydrogen fluoride: Not detected



Ammonia: Below levels of concern



Formaldehyde: Findings consistent with common indoor sources; below levels of concern.



DUST WIPE SAMPLES



Lead: Not detected indoors



Manganese: Below levels of concern



All levels below regulatory action levels



SOIL SAMPLES



Metals below levels of concern



Not unusual in older urban communities due to historical sources.



Above lead screening levels at 2 schools; areas fenced off pending evaluation.



OVERALL FINDING

Schools in Boyle Heights and East Los Angeles **remain safe** for occupancy.

ONGOING PROTECTIVE MEASURES



Routine cleaning of school facilities



Maintain HVAC filtration systems



Use air purifiers (HEPA & activate-carbon) as needed.



Limit outdoor activities if odors present
