PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IN PARKING STRUCTURES

NOVEMBER 2004

There have been recent reports of employees exercising within the parking structures for the Beaudry Building. Using parking structures for this purpose is unsafe.

- Although parking structures are ventilated, excessive exposure to automobile exhaust can be hazardous.
- Parking structures do not typically have delineated pedestrian pathways, which may increase the risk of being struck by an automobile.
- Motor oil and other fluids within parking areas can make floors slippery.

Please note that walking up or down parking structure ramps or exercising within parking areas is prohibited.
