YOU HAVE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS:

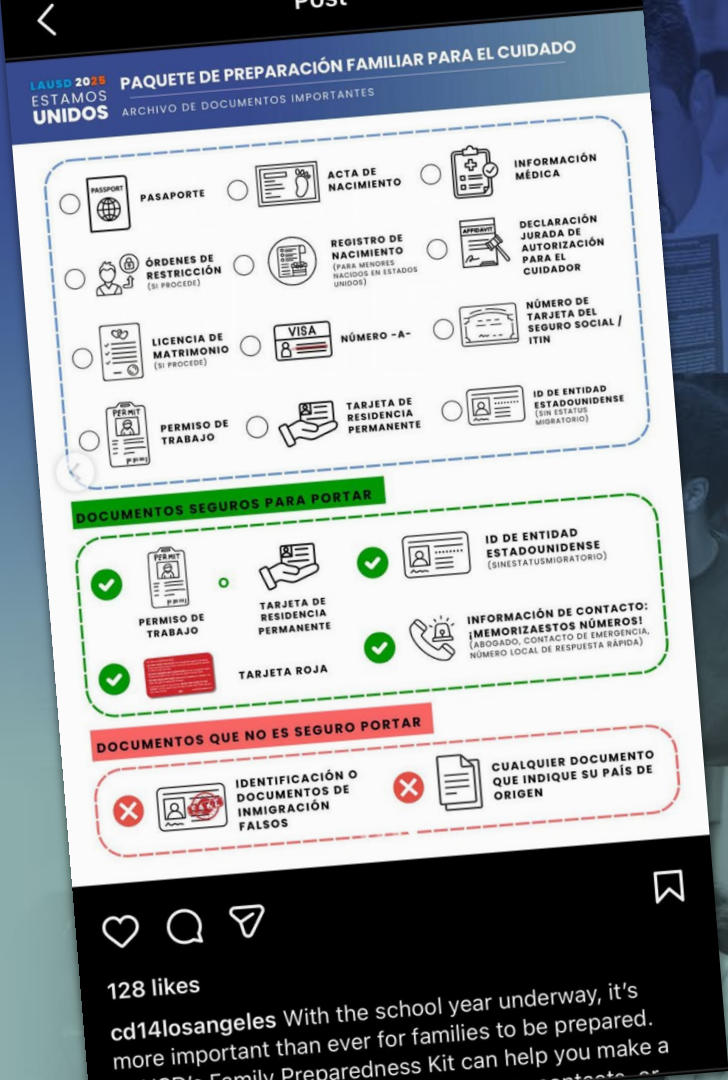
- **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR** if an immigration agent is knocking on the door.
- **DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS** from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- **DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING** without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your home, ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say yes, leave calmly.
- **GIVE THIS CARD TO THE AGENT.** If you are inside of your home, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.

I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution. I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you slide under the door. I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th Amendment rights. I choose to exercise my constitutional rights.

These cards are available to citizens and noncitizens alike.

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

- Regular case updates
- Signing contracts
- Copies of all documents submitted/received

3 KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

DESIGNATE A TRUSTED ADULT

- Temporary or Permanent Guardianship
- State-specific form
- Verbal Agreement

IF ICE IS AT THE DOOR

- DO NOT open the door unless ICE has a judge-signed warrant with your correct address and name on it
- DO NOT answer questions or share personal information
- DO NOT sign anything
- Maintain important contacts
- Use a Know Your Rights Red Card
- Remain Calm

- USE THE LASAR APP OR CALL LASPD COMMUNICATIONS AT (213) 625-6631 TO ALERT SCHOOLS OF IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ACTION.**
The Los Angeles Schools Anonymous Reporting (LASAR) app allows the school community to anonymously report non-emergency events—such as Immigration and Customs Enforcement activity near an LAUSD school—and share the location for an appropriate response. Families and community members can also contact LASPD Communications at (213) 625-6631.
