Sexual Health Education

CA Healthy Youth Act (CHYA), 2016

- The bill <u>requires</u> school districts to ensure that all pupils in grades seven to twelve, inclusive, receive comprehensive sexual health education and HIV prevention education.
- Provides guidelines on content for middle and high school
- Provides guidelines on delivery for elementary, middle, and high school

LGBTQ+ Affirming

"Affirming health education and services help youth understand gender identity and sexual orientation with age appropriate and medically accurate information; incorporate positive examples of LGBTQ individuals, romantic relationships and families; emphasize the need for protection during sex for people of all identities; and dispel common myths and stereotypes about behavior and identity."
