Engagement Overview and Methodology



Solicited Input from stakeholders to help inform the development of the 2023-2026 instructional calendars

Labor Partners

Meetings held on December 12, 2022, and January 12, 2023

<u>Families</u>

- Online Survey
 - January 9 19, 2023
 - Open to all District families; 52,414 participants
- Family Focus Groups
 - 6 sessions conducted via zoom on January 27, February 1, & February 2, 2023
 - Parents/guardians recommended by Region Leadership
 - 207 parents/guardians representing 250 students participated

Board of Education

- January 24, 2023, and February 14, 2023, Committee of the Whole meetings
- Included opportunities for public comment

Research and Analysis



- National and Neighboring School Districts' Instructional Calendars
- Overlay and assessment of testing schedule with proposed calendars
- Impact of vacation length on academic achievement
- Assessment of Admissions Day
- Average attendance rate for the day after Halloween (November 1)

Key Findings



- At least 78% of families engaged through both modes prefer a oneweek Thanksgiving break
- More than 70% of families engaged through both modes prefer a three-week Winter break
- Labor Partners overwhelmingly prefer a one-week Thanksgiving and a three-week Winter break
- While results of all engagement effort support a three-week Winter break, it creates challenges for our neediest families that must be considered in decision-making

Key Findings

Continued




- A super majority of the national and neighboring school districts surveyed provide a one-week Thanksgiving break and a twoweek Winter break
- A two-week winter break would provide more time for instruction before high stakes testing begins
- Attendance the day after Halloween does not significantly decline
- Neighboring school districts have made December 22 an unassigned day for the 2023-2024 school year



1 Week Thanksgiving Break:

- More valuable time with extended family
- Opportunity to learn and engage in family traditions
- Mental and physical health
- Ability to tour college campuses

Focus Group Key Themes



2-Week Winter Break

- Financial concerns
- Food insecurity
- Limited recreational activities
- Opportunity for expanded summer learning
- Learning loss, especially for students with special needs

3-Week Winter Break:

- Familiarity status quo
- More self-care time for children and adults
- Preventing seasonal illness
- Opportunity to travel
- Extended family time
- Ample time for college application process

Impacts on Academic Achievement Research

School Calendar and Breaks

- Research has generally focused on traditional vs. year-round calendars and summer learning loss (SLL) and its impact on academic achievement
- No research study found specifically on the length of winter break and its impact on academic achievement
- On average, students' achievement scores declined over summer vacation by one month's worth of school-year learning
 - Declines were sharper for math than for reading
 - The extent of loss was larger at higher grade levels (Quinn & Polikoff, 2017 citing Cooper, 1996)
 - The gap between children of high and low socioeconomic status (SES) has been reported to grow fastest during summer (Downey et al. 2004; Entwisle and Alexander 1992)
 - The gap between African American and White children has been reported to grow fastest during school (Condron 2009; Downey et al. 2004; Entwisle and Alexander 1994)

Admission Day



- Admission Day has been in bargaining unit contracts as a paid holiday for at least three decades
- For UTLA, the language dates back to 1988-1991
- The holiday is in accordance with the basis of the assignment
- Board Rule 1101 (Holidays) was last amended on 9-25-1989
- Removing Admission Day
 - requires Labor Unions notification
 - could result in the reduction in the number of employee paid holidays or the identification of an alternative paid holiday

- The Friday before the Winter break (SY 2023-2024) is an unassigned day







Summary



Calendar Options

- Now only considering a one-week option for Thanksgiving break
 - Results of engagement overwhelmingly indicate a desire for a one-week Thanksgiving break
 - There is no research that indicates such a break has a negative impact on learning and/or testing
- Assessment of duration of Winter break continues
 - Results of engagement also overwhelmingly indicate a desire for a three-week Winter break
 - Other data points suggest a change to historic practices should be seriously considered
 - A super majority of the national and neighboring school districts surveyed provide a one-week Thanksgiving break and a two-week Winter break
 - A two-week winter break would provide more time for instruction before high stakes testing begins
