Grades <u>6-8</u>	Beginning January 2027	<u>Limits:</u> <u>0-60 minutes per subject per week</u> <u>(Homework included. Guidance will be provided.)</u>	1:1 Device Model	
Grades <u>9-12</u>		Limits: 0- <u>90</u> minutes per <u>subject per week</u> (Homework included. Guidance will be provided.)
