## **Proposition 39 Regulatory Process**

November 1*	Prop. 39 facilities request from charter school due to District	✓
December 1	District accepts/objects to charter school's in-District ADA projection	✓
January 2	Charter school provides response to District's objections to ADA projections	$\checkmark$
February 1	District sends Preliminary Proposal of space to charter school**	✓
March 1	Charter school responds to District's Preliminary Proposal	<b>√</b>
April 1	District sends Final Offer of space to charter school	<b>✓</b>
May 1	Charter school accepts or declines Final Offer	
Occupancy	Site must be prepared for charter school occupancy 10 working days prior to its first day of instruction	

<sup>\*</sup>Prior to Nov. 1, LAUSD principals complete E-CAR, and the District documents its anticipated space needs for following school year.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Board of Education must first make a finding that the charter school cannot be accommodated at a single site and adopt a written statement of reasons explaining the finding

## Proposition 39 Status Update

- 27 Final Offers issued for 32 District sites
- 14 Alternative Agreements executed for charter schools to occupy 14 District sites
  - 7 District sites will not have a co-location as a result of these agreements
- 5 Withdrawals of facilities requests
  - 7 District sites will not have a Prop. 39 co-location as a result

(as of April 1, 2024)



## **Proposition 39 Status Update**

- 46 of the 48 (96%) potential co-locations are existing.
- Of the 48 potential charter co-locations:
  - o 2 are new
  - 15 are projected to have no change
  - 19 are projected to have growth
  - 8 are projected to have reductions
  - 4 are projected to be a reconfiguration
- Additional potential alternative agreement concepts continue to be assessed, as appropriate.
- 7 charter schools are identified to potentially occupy multiple District school sites.

In collaboration with ITS, the CSD website is being redesigned in alignment to the September 26, 2023 Board Resolution.


The revised website includes an updated user interface in addition to new content and features.





The revised website includes a **Charter Schools Clearinghouse** which provides the public with:


- Approved Charter Petitions

- Additional Reports and Data






For example, the Clearinghouse provides direct access to each LAUSD-authorized charter school's operative charter and, as applicable, material revisions.








The revised website also includes a new feature that provides performance data and information about each LAUSD-authorized charter school.








This feature includes a search function to directly access publicly available data and information for LAUSD-authorized charter schools.
