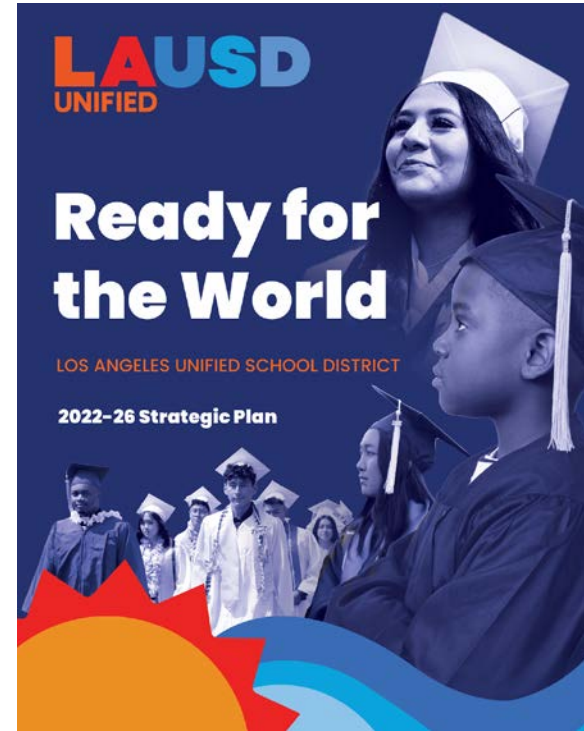

(Curricular Trips) Cultural arts experiences are in-person or virtual, and may include:

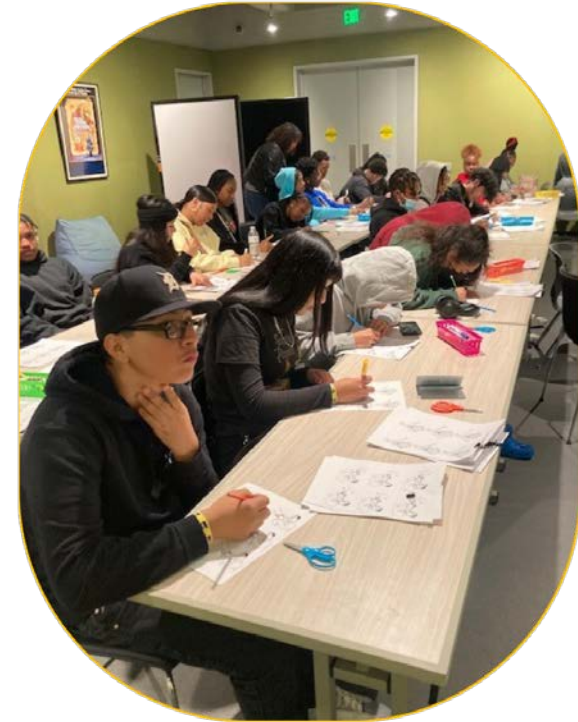
- Local cultural experiences, including LAUSD sites

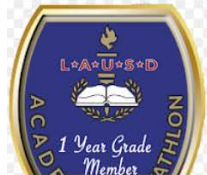

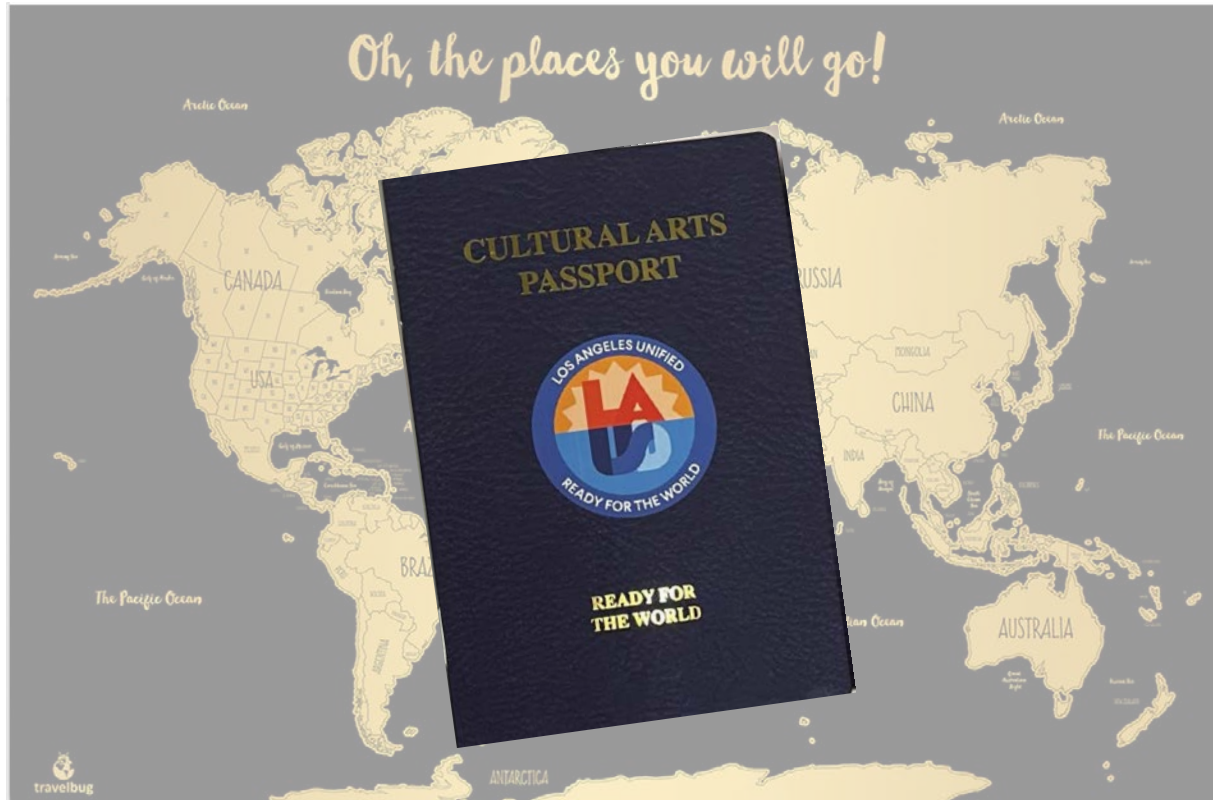

## Tracking Data on Cultural Experiences



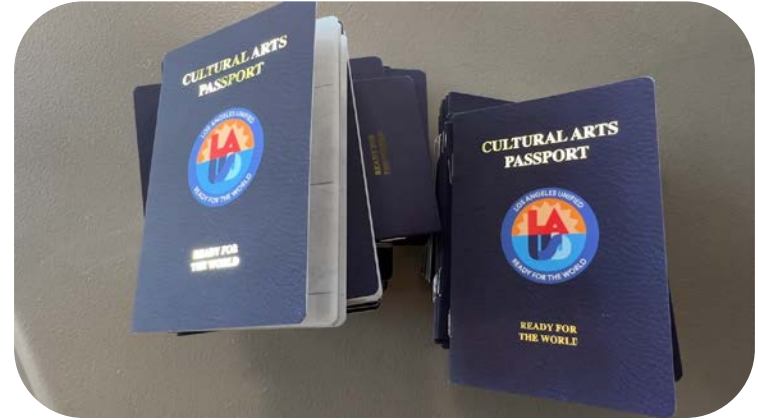
Student participation in cultural arts experiences will be recorded in LAUSD's Student Information System MiSiS
