




#### Cultural Arts Passport Background

#### **Cultural Arts Passport Champion**

 Arts Champion (Certificated Staff) in every school who leads professional development, organizes school events, performances, and curricular trips

#### **Cultural Arts Passport Experiences**

(Curricular Trips) Cultural arts experiences are in-person or virtual, and may include:

- Local cultural experiences, including LAUSD sites
- Cultural arts fair: Students showcase both performing and visual arts, attend cultural arts workshops
- Cultural experiences across America
- International cultural experiences




## Cultural Arts Passport Badges in Schoology
