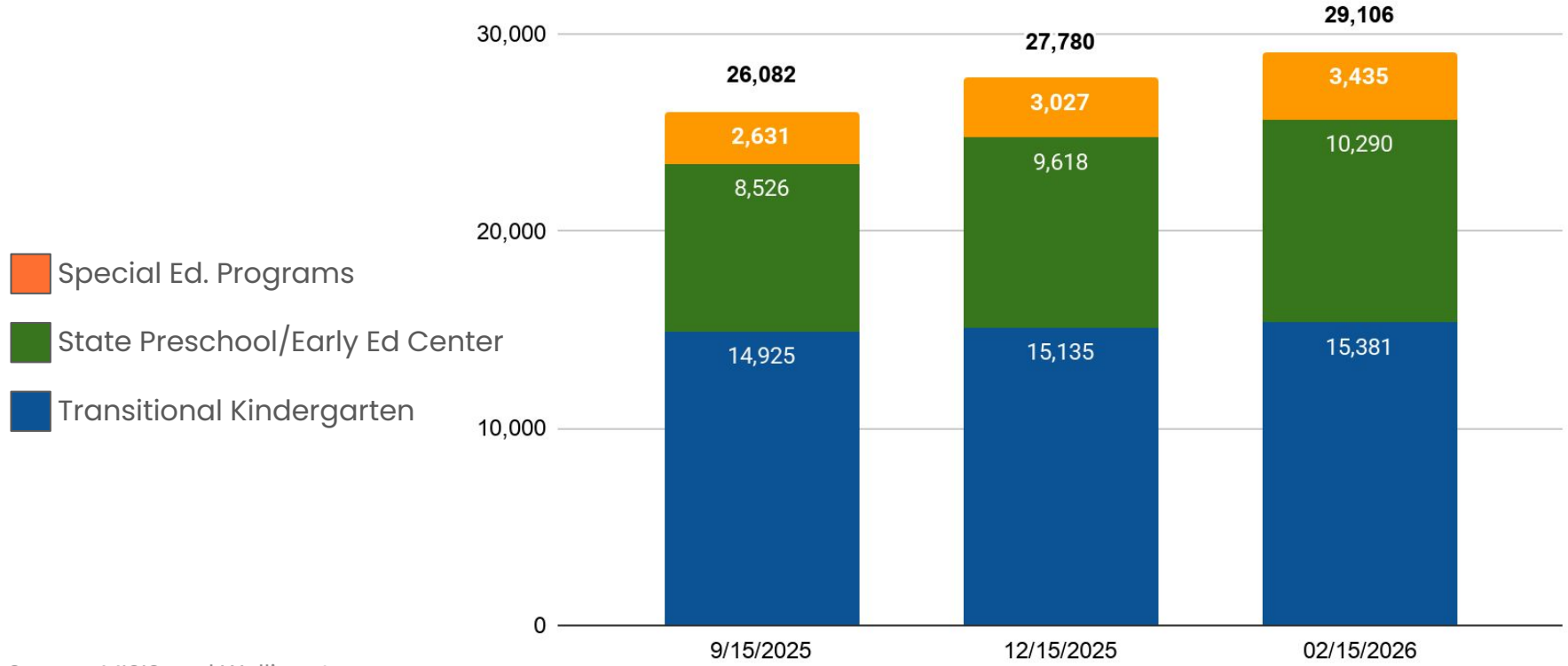

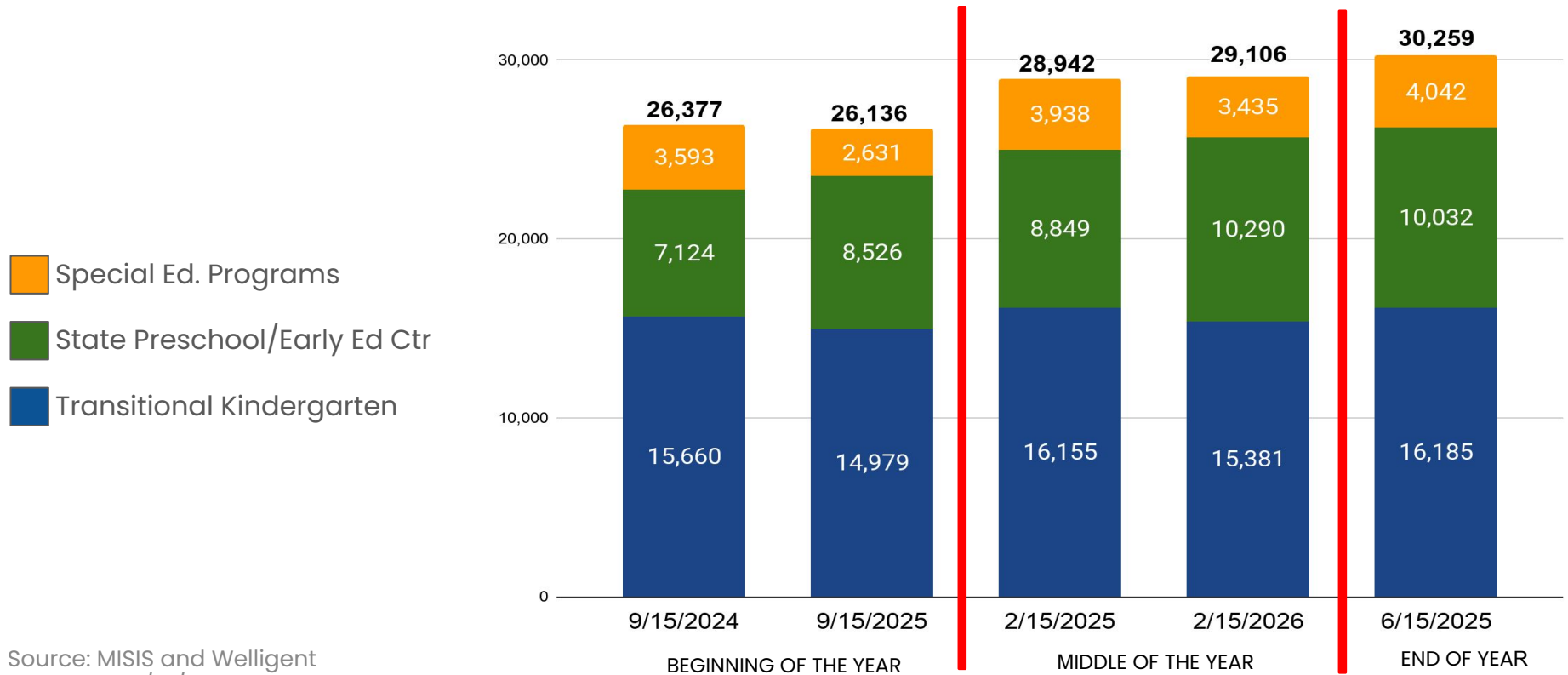

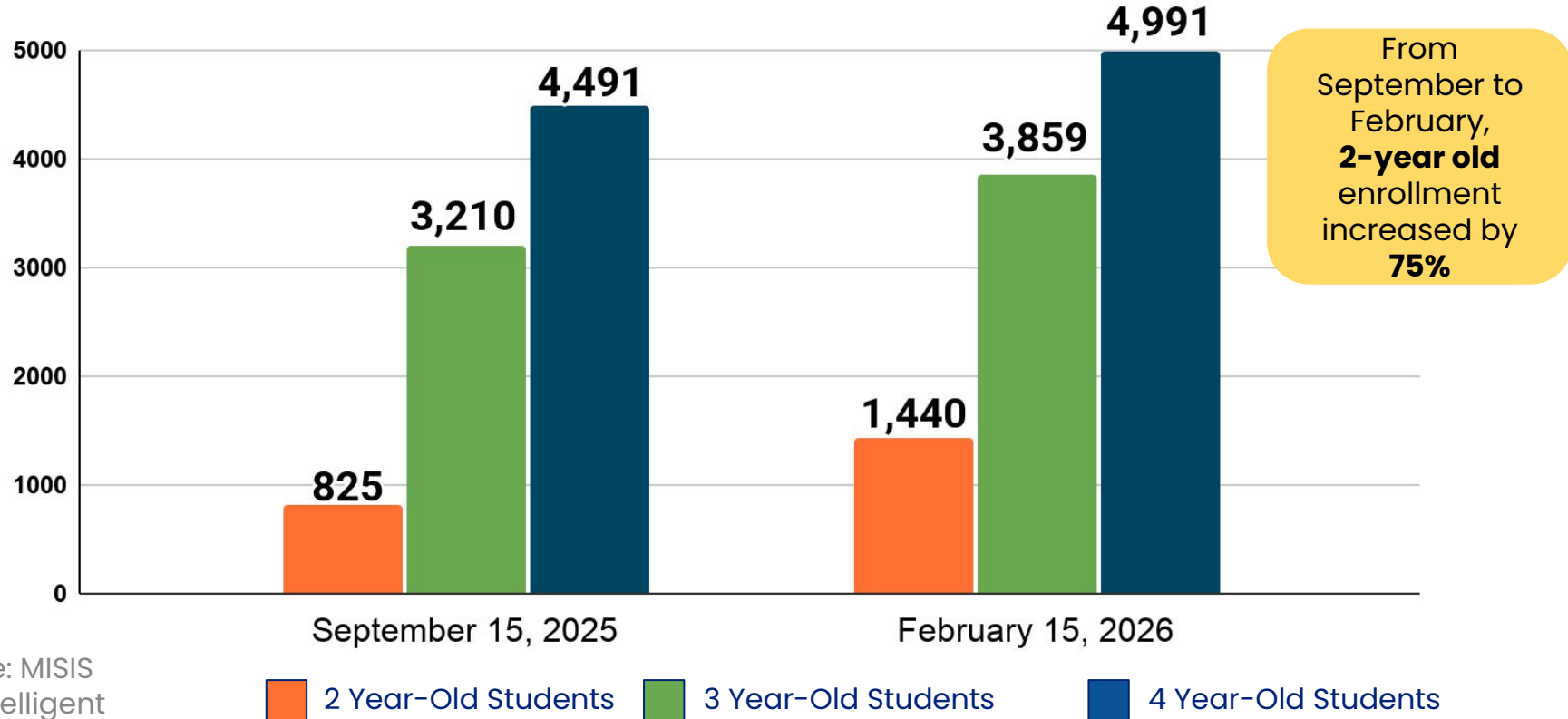
Transitional Kindergarten and Preschool Enrollment for 2024–25 and 2025–26

Preschool Enrollment by Student Age



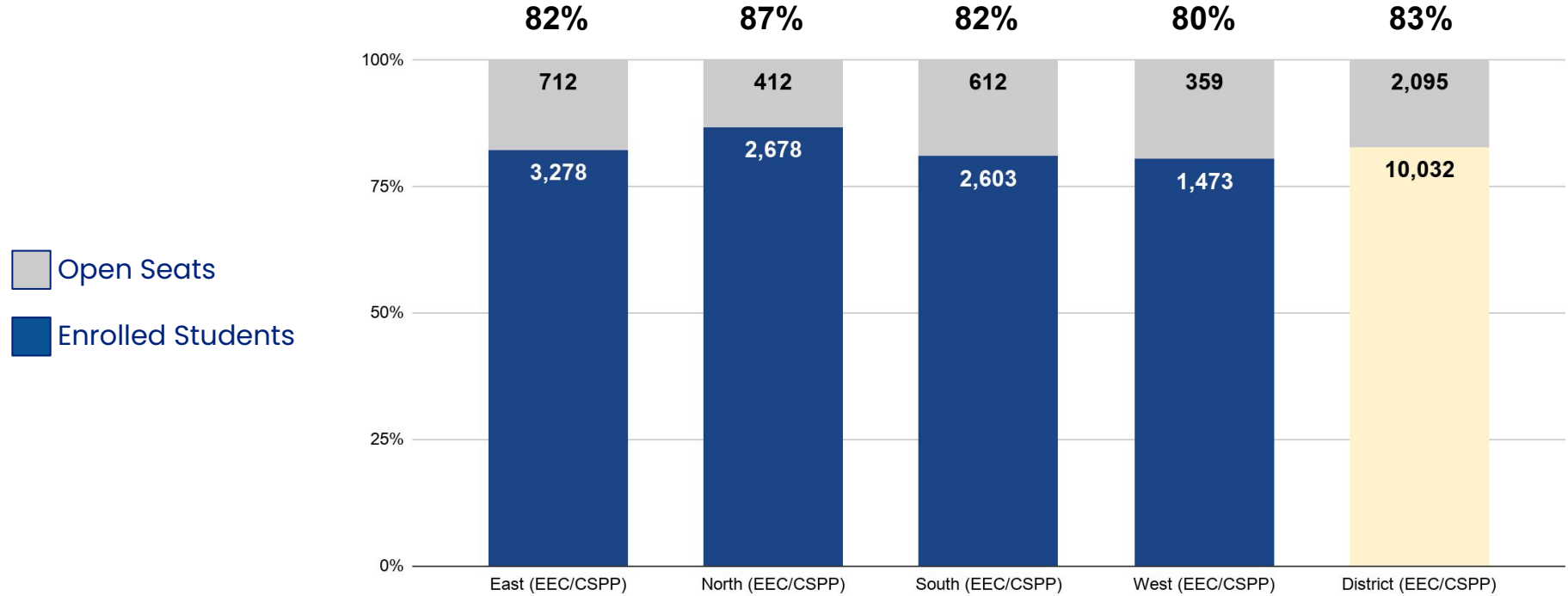

Preschool Enrollment and Capacity by Region

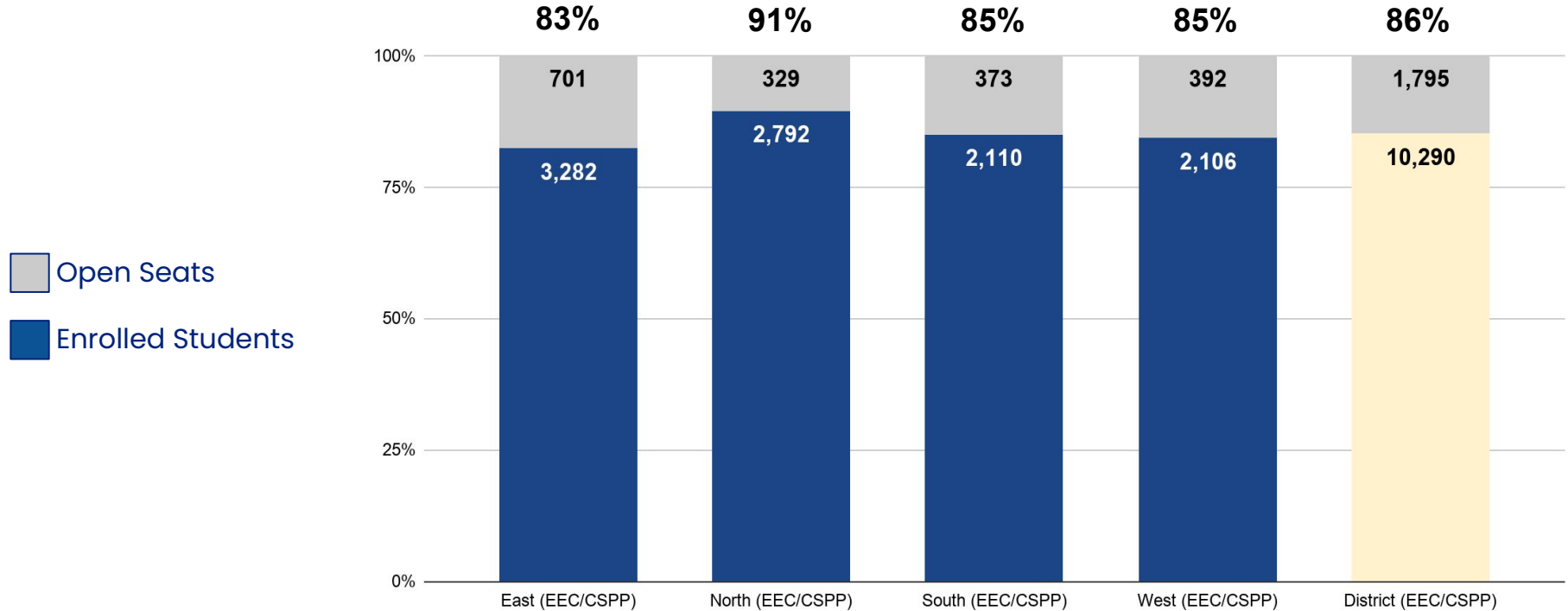

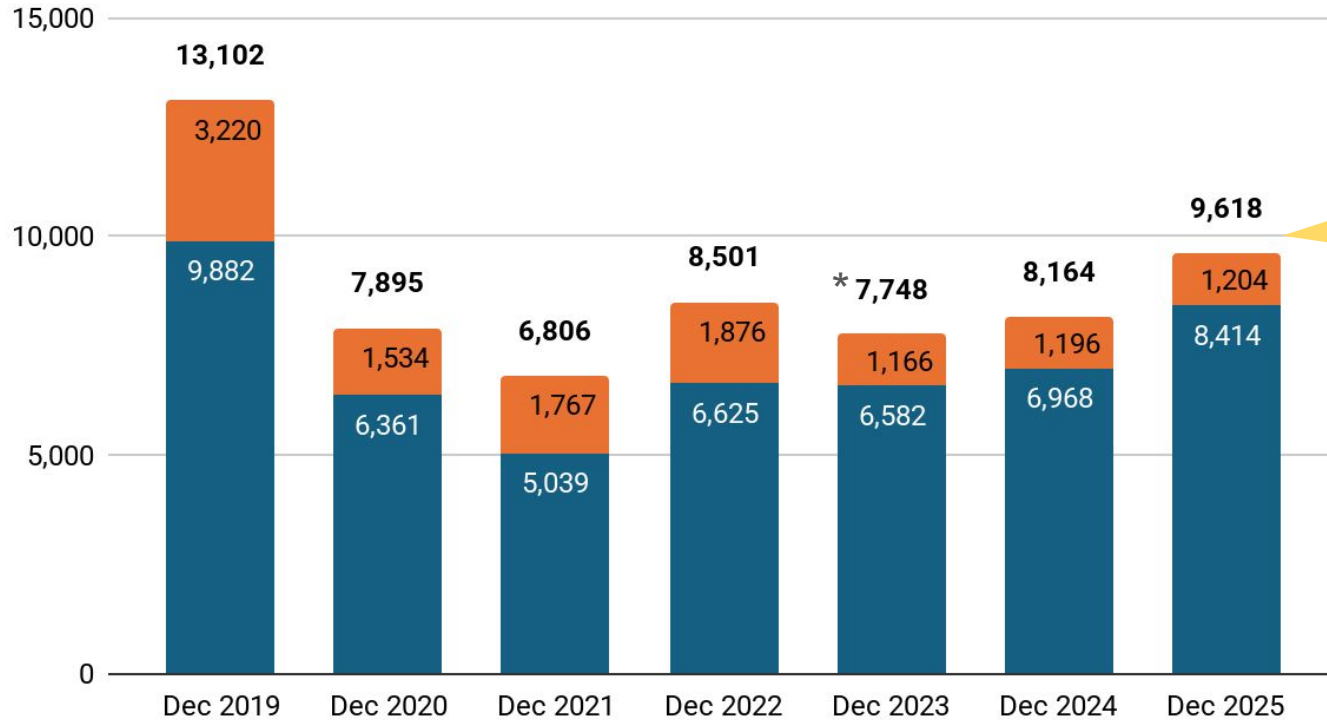
