These gatherings not only offer a space to learn but also create moments for connection, mutual support, and community-building. Let's grow stronger—together.

YOU HAVE CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS:

- **DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR** if an immigration agent is knocking on the door.
- **DO NOT ANSWER ANY QUESTIONS** from an immigration agent if they try to talk to you. You have the right to remain silent.
- **DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING** without first speaking to a lawyer. You have the right to speak with a lawyer.
- If you are outside of your home, ask the agent if you are free to leave and if they say yes, leave calmly.
- **GIVE THIS CARD TO THE AGENT.** If you are inside of your home, show the card through the window or slide it under the door.

I do not wish to speak with you, answer your questions, or sign or hand you any documents based on my 5th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution. I do not give you permission to enter my home based on my 4th Amendment rights under the United States Constitution unless you have a warrant to enter, signed by a judge or magistrate with my name on it that you slide under the door. I do not give you permission to search any of my belongings based on my 4th Amendment rights. I choose to exercise my constitutional rights.

These cards are available to citizens and noncitizens alike.

- Update emergency contacts
- Share copies of medical information
- Ensure your child has a passport

2 IMMIGRATION OPTIONS

UNDERSTAND WHO CAN GIVE IMMIGRATION ADVICE & REPRESENT YOU

- Licensed Attorneys
- DOJ Accredited Representatives

WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

- Regular case updates
- Signing contracts
- Copies of all documents submitted/received

3 KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

DESIGNATE A TRUSTED ADULT

- Temporary or Permanent Guardianship
- State-specific form
- Verbal Agreement

IF ICE IS AT THE DOOR

- DO NOT open the door
- DO NOT answer questions or share personal information
- DO NOT sign anything
- Memorize important contacts
- Use a Know Your Rights Red Card
- Remain Calm
