Purpose of Presentation

- To fulfill the California Department of Education's corrective action directive in Case S-0909-24/25.
- Specifically, CDE required the Division of Special Education to present the findings of noncompliance to this Board Committee.



CDE Findings – Case S-0909-24/25

- CDE investigated an allegation that the District failed to implement a Final Settlement Agreement dated February 1, 2024.
- The agreement required reimbursement to the parent for Language and Speech (LAS), Occupational Therapy (OT), and tutoring services.
- The District was approximately 8 months late in providing reimbursements to the parents, totaling \$6,425.
- CDE found this delay constituted noncompliance.



Steps Taken by the Division of Special Education To Address Reimbursement Concerns

- Implemented a centralized tracking system for all settlement-related reimbursements.
- Established internal deadlines to ensure timely processing well in advance of the 60-day window.
- Issued direct guidance to fiscal staff on prompt implementation.
- Strengthened coordination between legal, fiscal, and program teams to improve follow-through.

- The Division of Special Education is committed to the timely fulfillment of all settlement obligations.
- We will continue strengthening internal systems to ensure prompt and accurate implementation of services for students and families.
