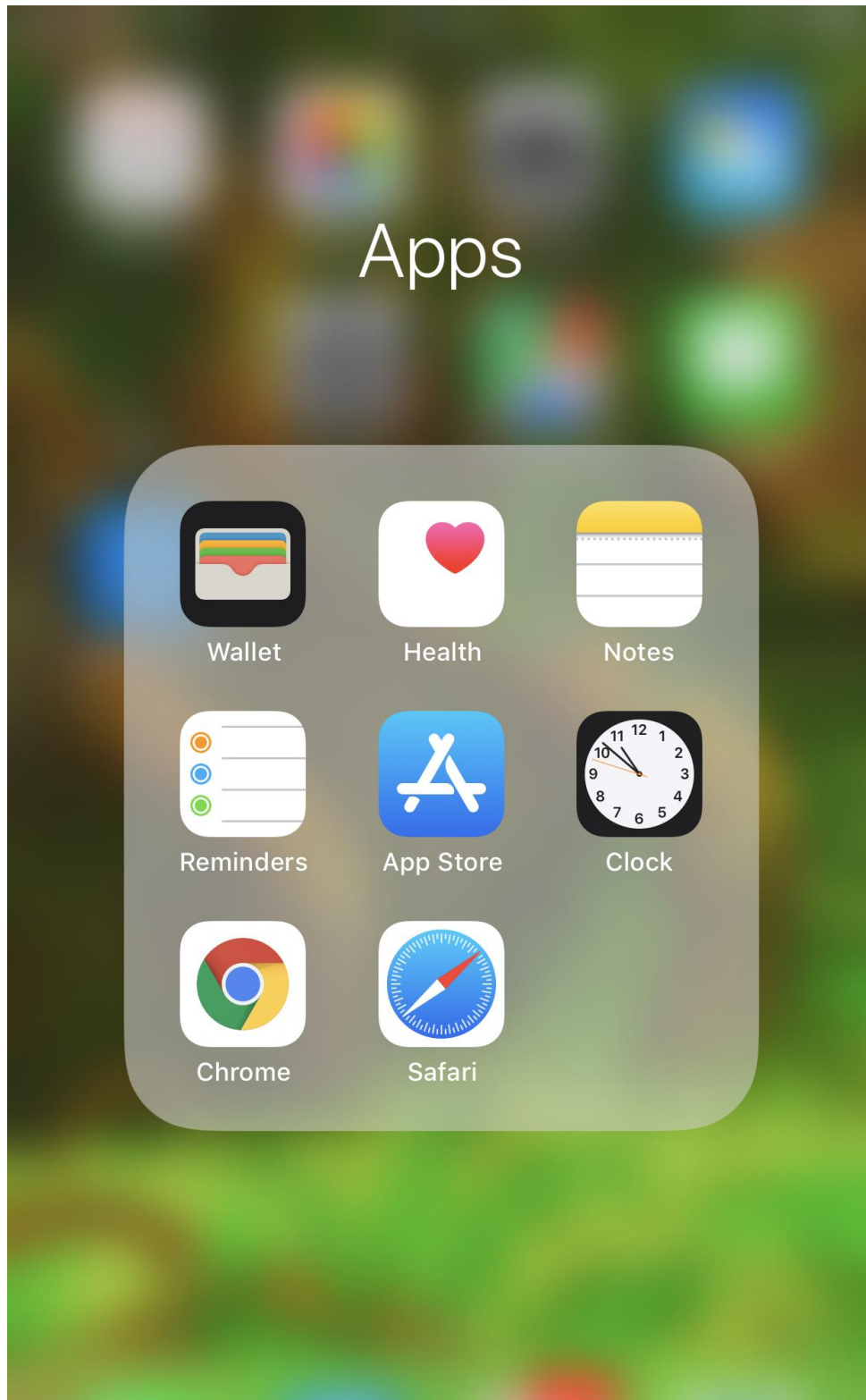


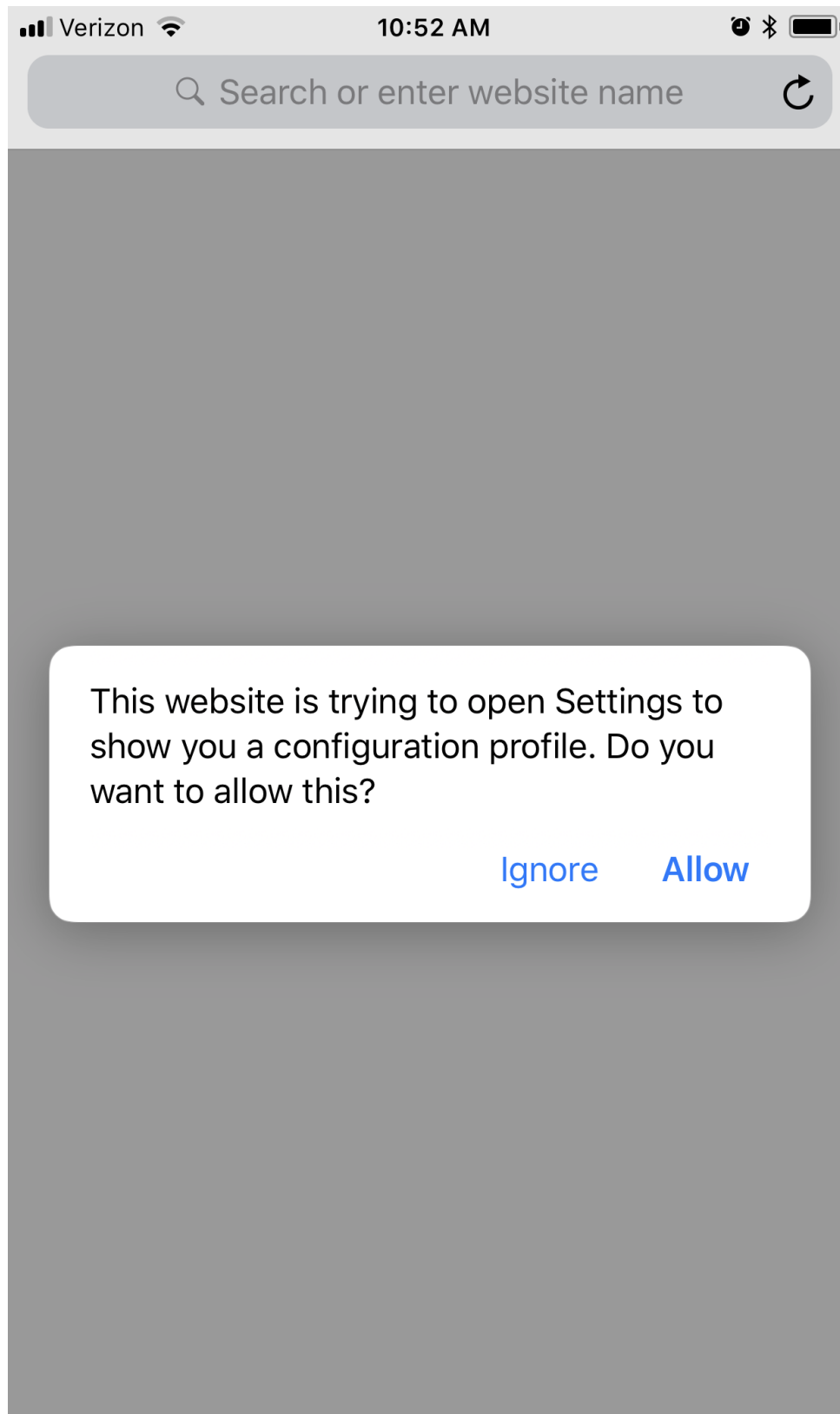
Certificate Installation for iOS Devices

Please see the following instruction for installing the Zscaler Certificate on iOS devices such as iPhones and iPads. The certificate can be downloaded [here](#).

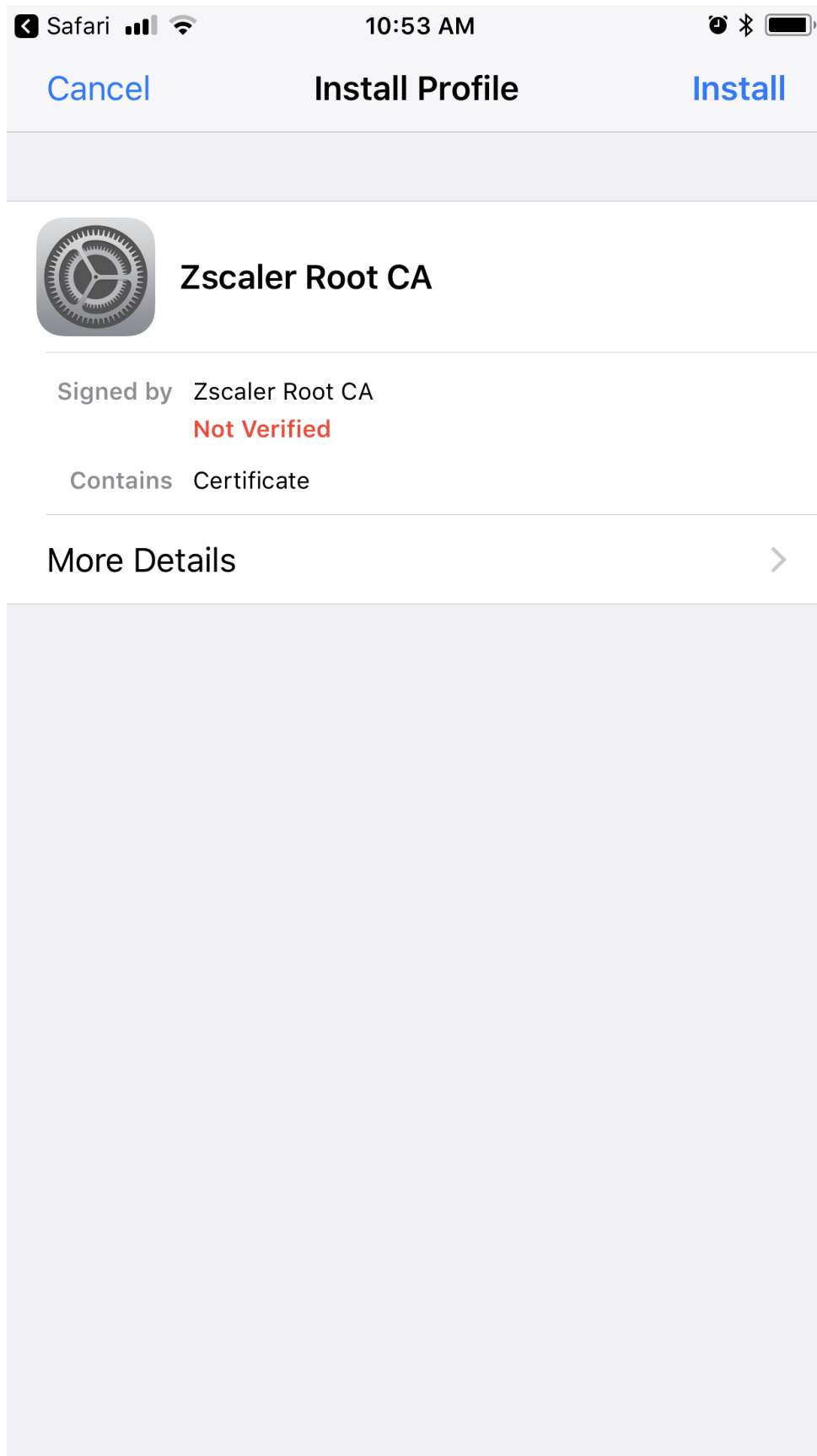
1. You will need to use the Safari Browser for the download to work correctly.



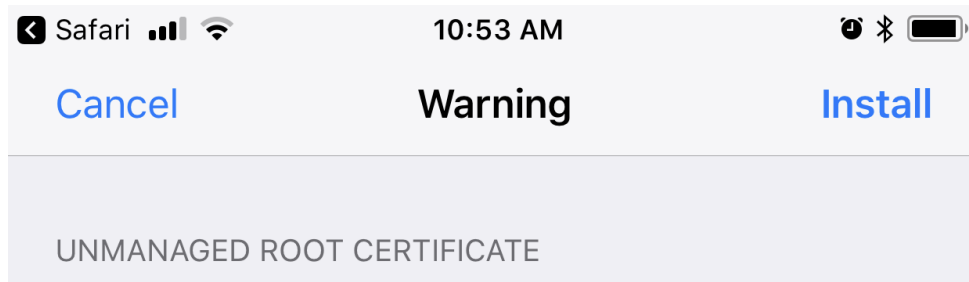
2. Once the Safari Browser is open copy the following URL into the address bar:
<http://www.ecps.us/ourpages/auto/2018/2/9/36752699953237325794/ZscalerRootCertificate-2048-SHA256.crt>. You should see the following screen. Select "Allow".



3. After selecting “Allow”, you should see the following screen. Select “Install”



4. After selecting "Install" you will be prompted to enter your PIN, or password if you have one, enter your PIN, or password and you should then see the following screen. Select "Install".

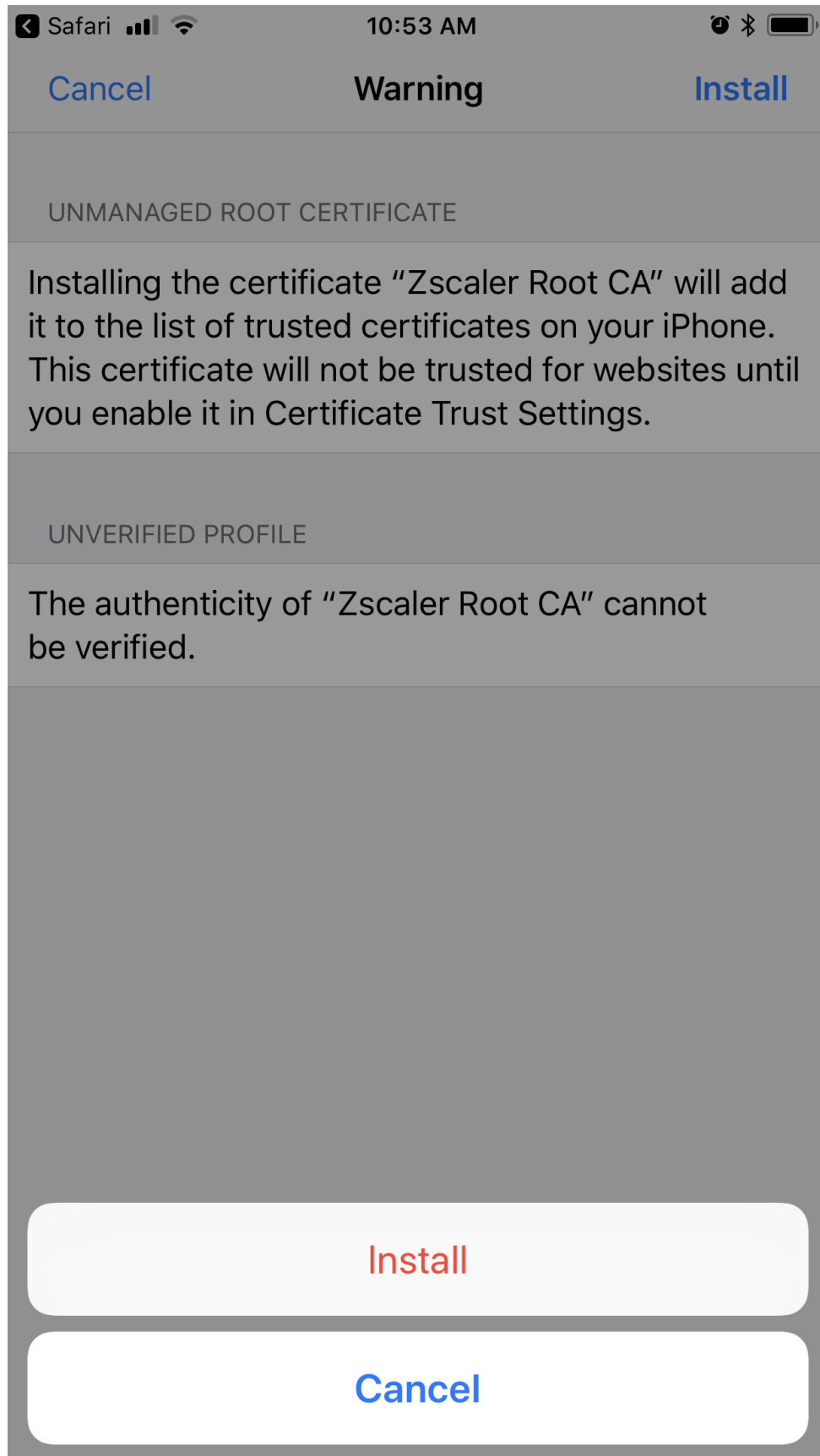


Installing the certificate "Zscaler Root CA" will add it to the list of trusted certificates on your iPhone. This certificate will not be trusted for websites until you enable it in Certificate Trust Settings.

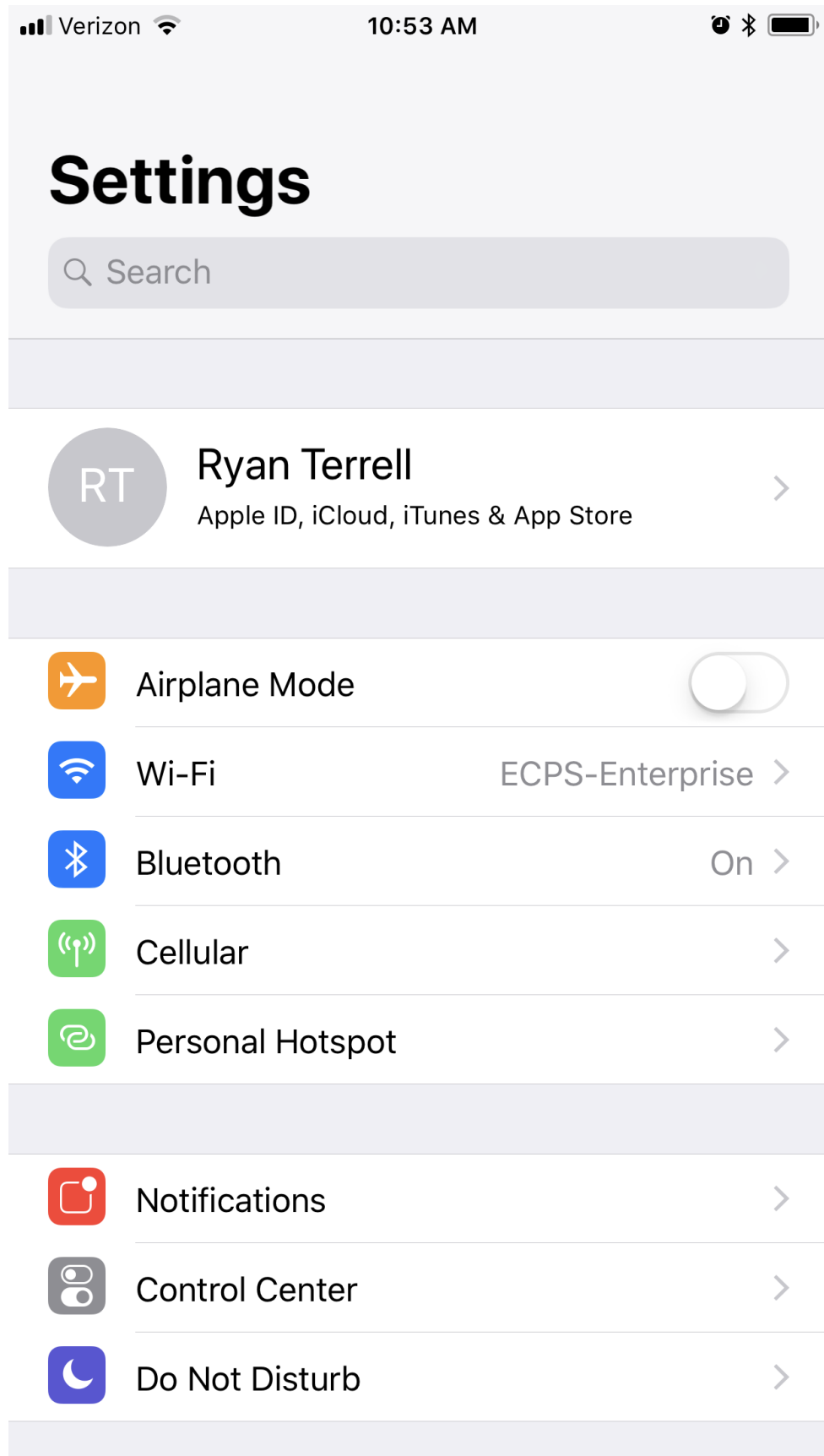

The authenticity of "Zscaler Root CA" cannot be verified.

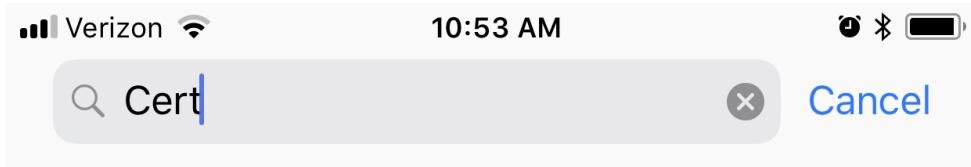
5. After selecting "Install" you will see the following screen, select "Install" at the bottom of the screen.



6. You should be taken back to Safari or your home screen at this point. Open Settings, and search for the word "Cert" from the home page in settings as seen below.

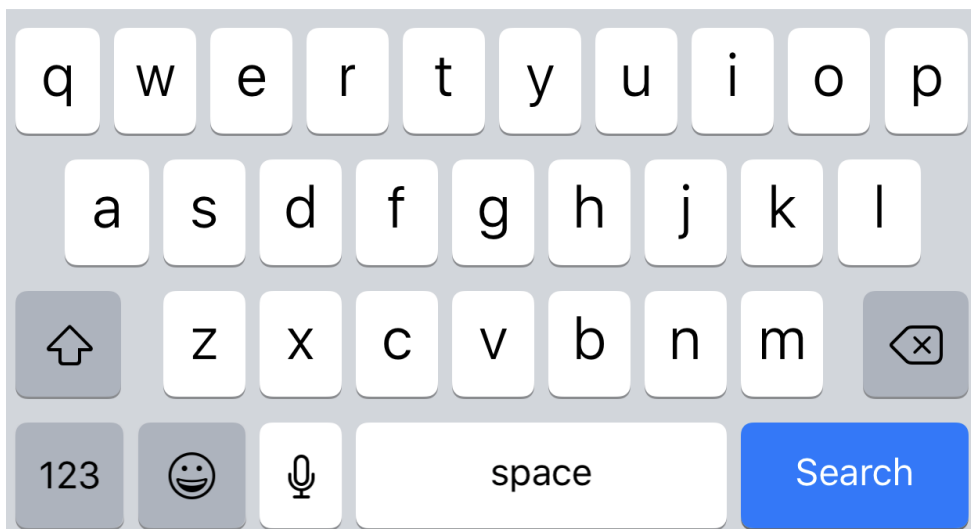


7. Search for “Cert” and select “Certificate Trust Settings”. If you see more options pop up you most likely have an older version of iOS and do not need to proceed to the next steps. If you see the screen below continue with these instructions.

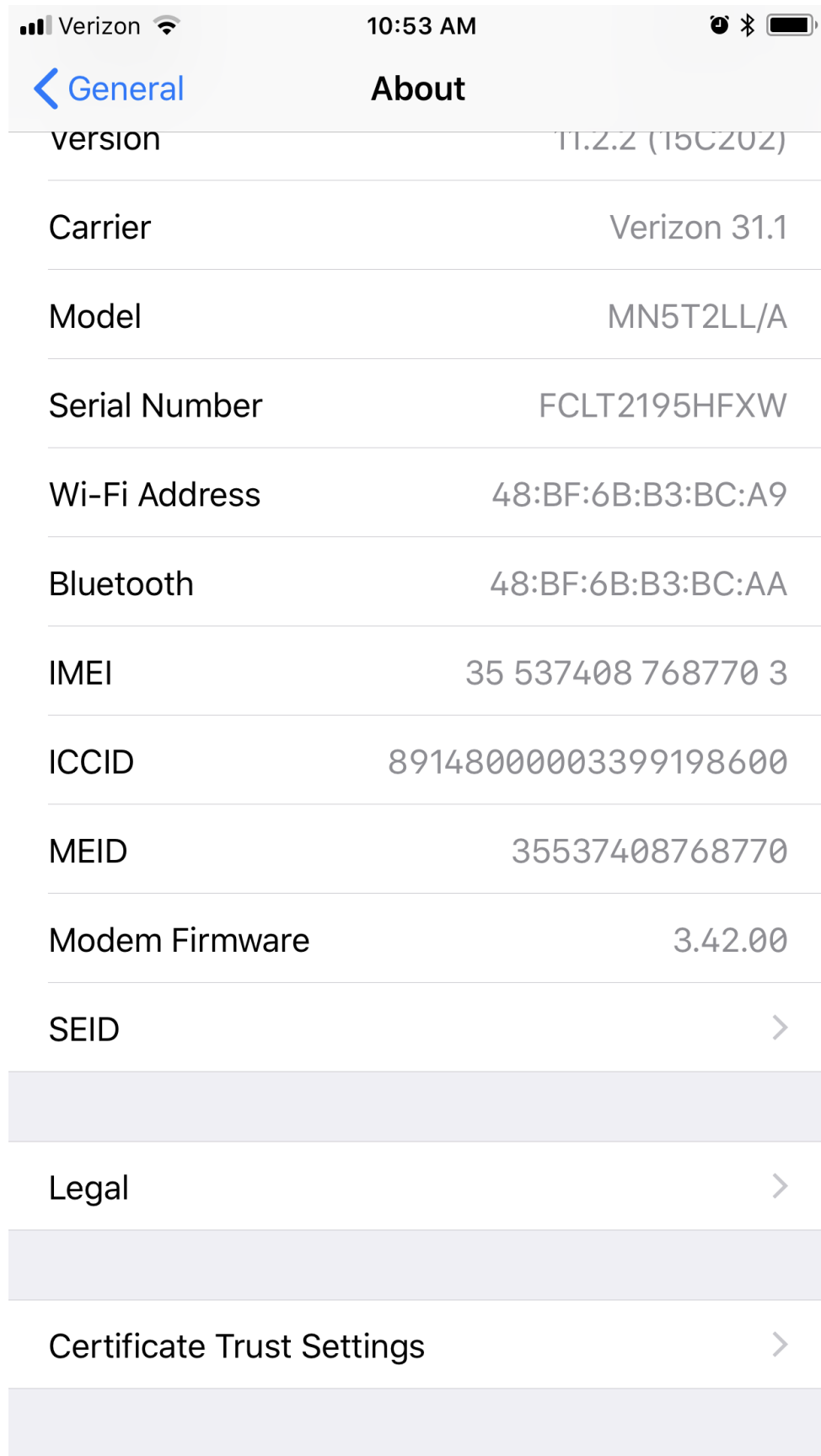

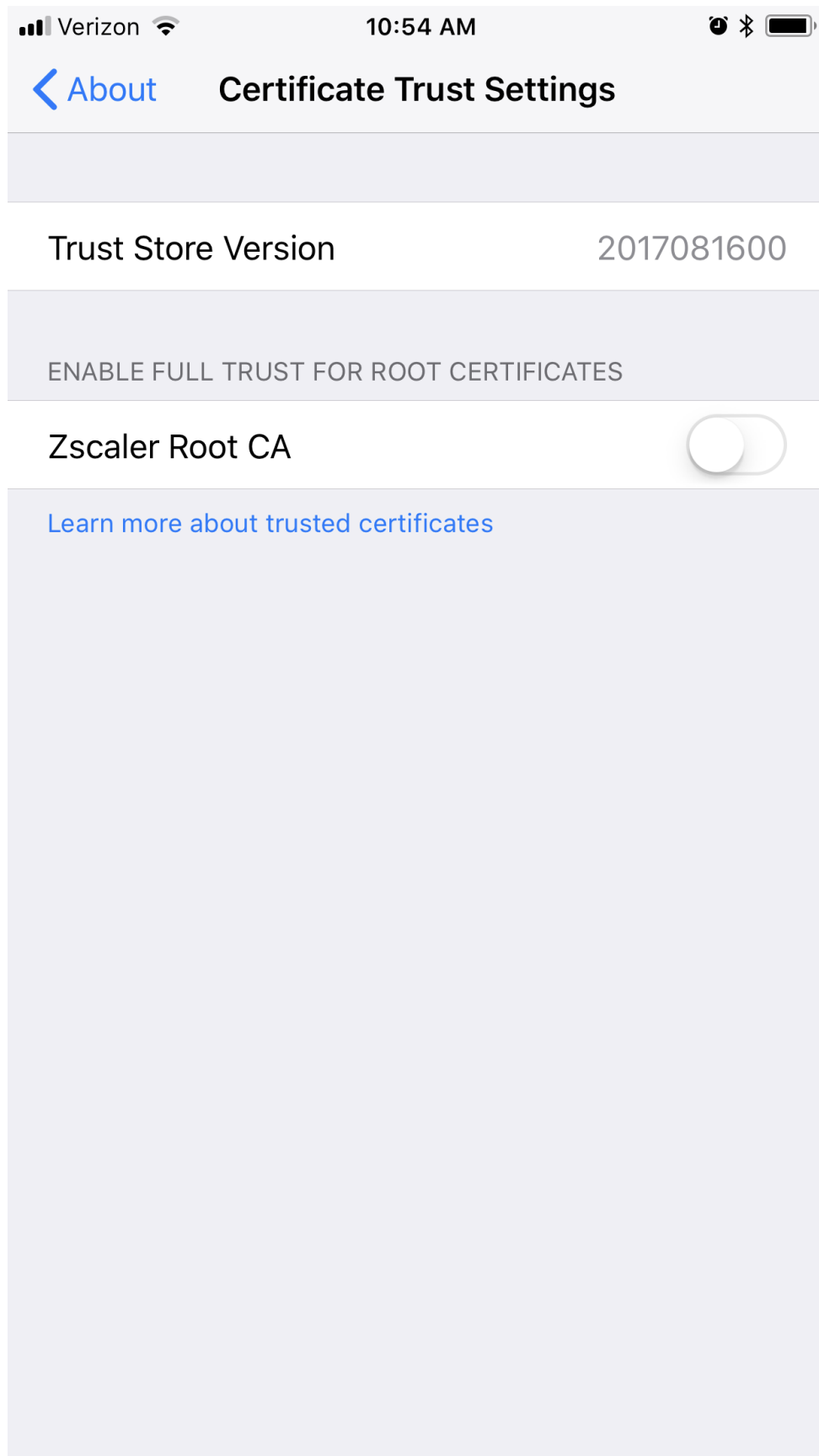

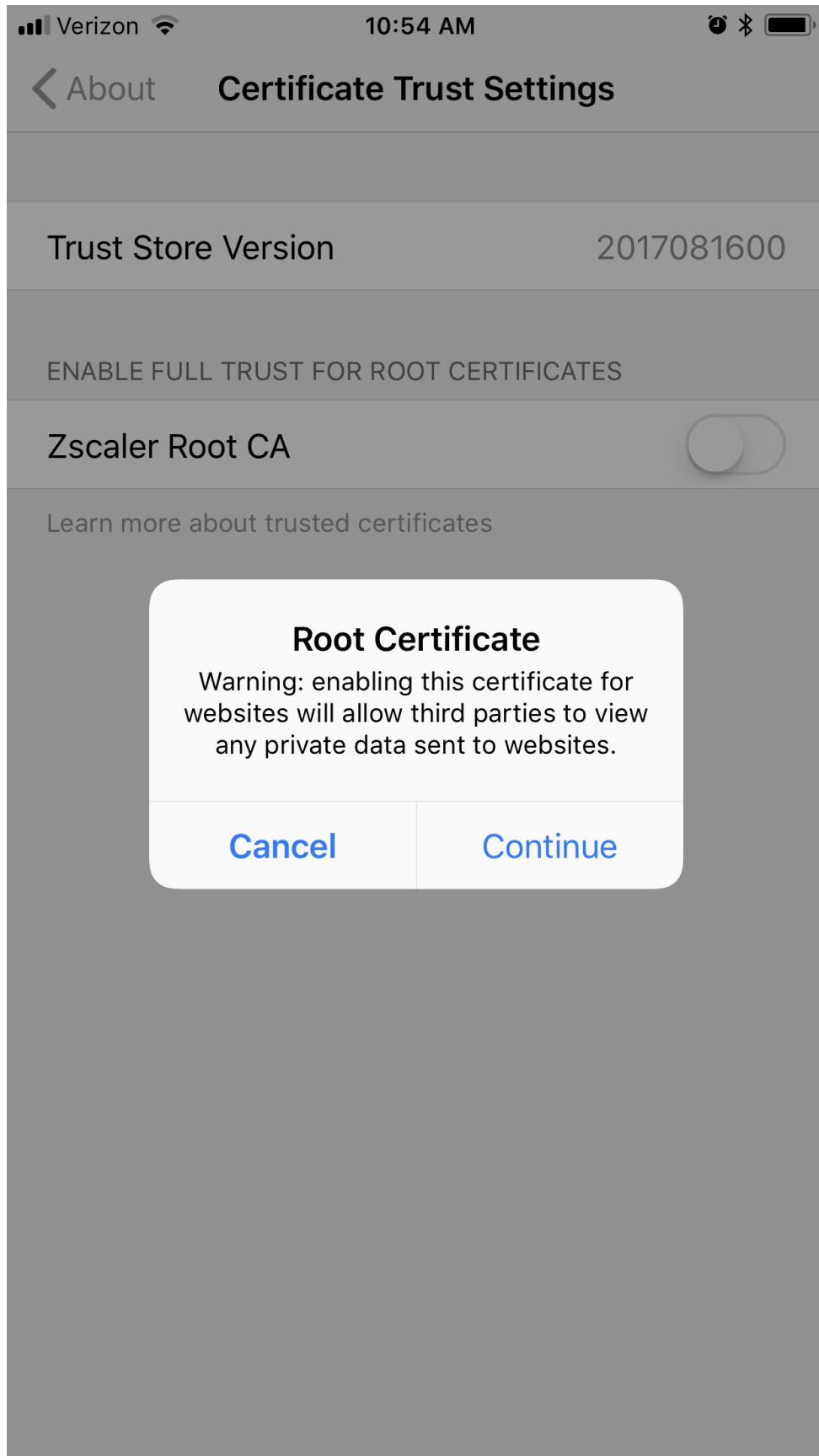
8. After selecting “Certificate Trust Settings” scroll to the bottom of the page and select the “Certificate Trust Settings” option as seen below.



9. The following screen will appear. You will need to switch the slider for Zscaler Root CA to the on position.



10. You will receive the warning below. Select "Continue"



11. You should now see a screen that looks like the following one, and have finished installing the Zscaler certificate. You may close the Settings app.
