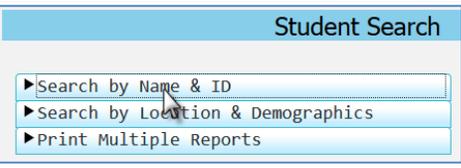
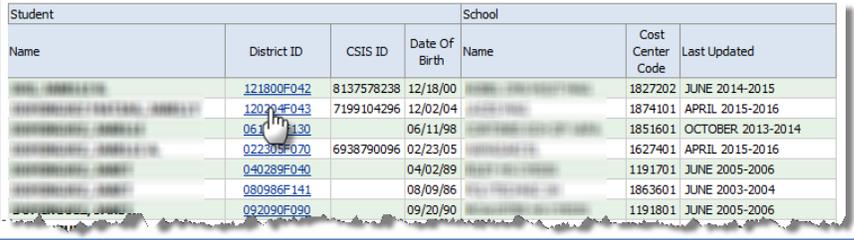
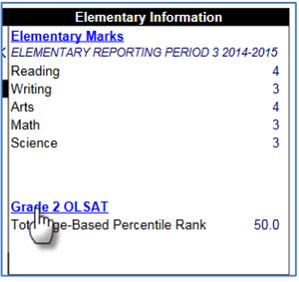
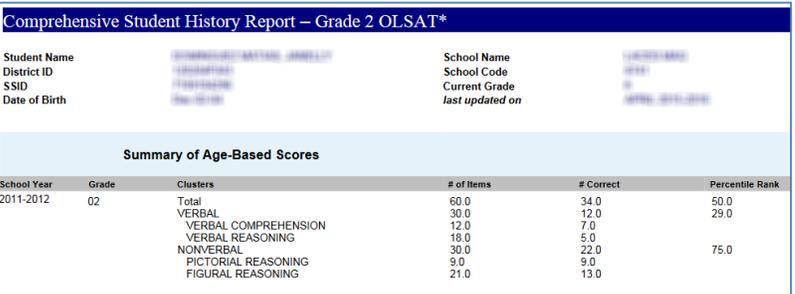


Q: Where can I find a student's OLSAT score?

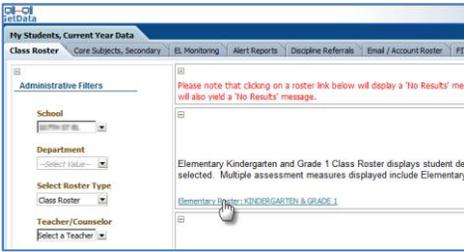
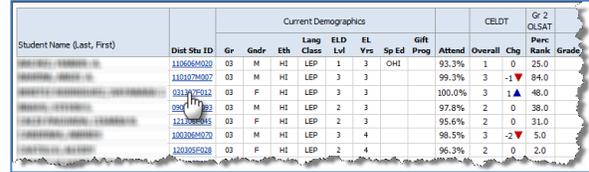
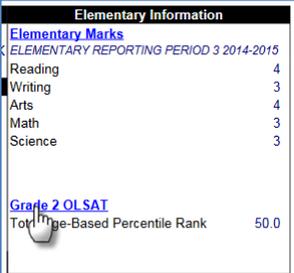
A: You can find them by going to the Comprehensive Student History Report.

Getting OLSAT scores for an individual student:

Step #	Step	Icon/Link	
1.	From the Student Search dashboard click Search by Name & ID		
2.	On the left-hand side under Basic Filters , type a student's Last Name, First Name or Student ID NOTE: Make sure you are using ALL CAPS.		<p><i>All entries must be typed using uppercase letters. Typing in lowercase letters will not yield any results.</i></p> <p><i>MyData needs only one of the three basic filters to return a list of matching students.</i></p>
3.	Locate your student from the list of students. Click on a student's District ID to load his/her history report.		
4.	This will open the Comprehensive Student History Report . Under the Elementary Information heading you will find Grade 2 OLSAT link. Click on the link.		<p><i>Moving your cursor over a summary heading will cause the pointer to change into a pointing finger, signaling that more information is available by clicking on it.</i></p>
5.	This will open the Grade 2 OLSAT detail report.		



Getting OLSAT scores for an entire class:

Step #	Step	Icon/Link	
1.	From the menu, click on Classroom and select the My Students, Current Year Data dashboard. (For teachers, you will already be on this page when you log in.)		If clicking on a student ID takes you to an Oracle BI Publisher log-in screen, enter your SSO username and password to get to the Student History Report.
2.	From the Class Roster tab, click on the Elementary Roster: GRADE 2-6 link.		This will open the Elementary Class Roster.
3.	The Gr 2 OLSAT column displays the percentile rank for the student.		Note that the Percentile Rank is the score given to the student when he first took the OLSAT in 2nd grade. It will display even if the child has moved up to the next grade. If the student has more than one OLSAT result, the one with the highest score will be displayed.
4.	To view how the student did on each of the clusters, click on the Student ID .
