




- The Initial Assessment window will be year-round (July–June), however it must be administered within 30 days of enrollment
- The Summative Assessment window will be a four-month window after January 1 (February 1–May 31, 2018)

Below are some of the basic administration facts about the new ELPAC:

- Administered in four domains:
 - Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing.
- Two separate assessments each year: an Initial Assessment and a Summative Assessment.
- Administered at seven grades/grade spans; kindergarten (K), 1, 2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-10 and 11-12.
- K and grade one (1) students are administered the test one-on-one.
- Speaking items are administered to all students one-on-one and scored by a trained test examiner "in real time."
- Group administration is provided for Listening, Reading and Writing at grades two through twelve (2–12).
- A paper-pencil assessment.
- The Listening domain at grades K-2 will be read aloud to students by a test examiner. At grades 3-12, recorded audio will be used to deliver Listening items.
- The Writing domain will be entirely constructed-response items.
- The Writing domain will not contain any multiple-choice items.
- The Initial Assessment will be shorter than the Summative Assessment
