- 1. Review the **Task Type**:
 - a. Identify the grade/grade span for this task
 - b. Check the **domain** that the ELPAC task assesses
 - c. Read the ELPAC **Task description**
- 2. Establish the **ELD standard**(s) the task assesses:
 - a. When reviewing the **Primary aligned ELD standard(s)** the task assesses, focus on the **Bridging level**, as that is the level to which the task has been written
 - b. List and review the **ELD standards with a Secondary (supporting) alignment**, if applicable (Speaking and Writing)
 - c. What **other standard(s)** are **embedded** within this item, if applicable?
- 3. Identify the **test actions**:
 - a. State what the **examiner** and the **student will do**
 - b. Record it in the "Test Actions" section of the ELPAC Task Planner
- 4. Identify the requisite **task requirements**:
 - a. State what the **student needs to know and do**
 - b. List these for all grade levels in the grade span
 - c. Record it in the "Task Requires the Student to..." section of the ELPAC Task Planner
- 5. Identify the **instructional shifts** needed to meet the demands of the task:
 - a. List the **instructional shifts** necessary for task completion. Consider practices or strategies that might need to be implemented and/or taught at your site to develop these **processes**, **skills**, **abilities**, **and knowledge** for English Learners
 - b. For each of these shifts, identify resources and practices
 - c. Label each resource and practice as "existing" or "needed"
