II. Operations Update

Mr. Ludwig presented handout. Grounds care has been very busy this year due to the result of frequent rain. As a result we have had more maintenance and fuel costs associated with equipment. Murray has been out a couple more times to repair roof leaks. Mr. Ludwig thinks that all leaks have been repaired. Paving project has been completed around the baseball softball areas. Temporary lighting was replaced on building 6 with properly installed conduit and new lights were added. This cleaned up the exterior of building 6. Softball scoreboard has been repaired and is working properly. New fans were installed inside the football concession stand to help with heat during events. The front entryway to the lobby of building 6 received new walk off carpet replacing the old grates that were in place. The football stadium, including bleachers, pavement and pavilion was power washed.
