



**Learning, Instruction, and Assessment Committee Minutes**

**I. Overview of Dyslexia Law**

Mrs. Ludwig presented a slideshow presentation containing details regarding the Dyslexia Law recently passed by Governor Dewine. The team engaged in conversation about how the Dyslexia Law will impact instruction at Warren Elementary. In addition, the team discussed purchases that will need to be made to support the law; including a multi-sensory phonics curriculum, teacher professional development, and a dyslexia screener. The district was awarded a grant to support implementation of the dyslexia law, Each Child Reads Grant. Although these funds will help support the implementation, it is likely that the purchases required will exceed total grant funds.

**II. District Priority Update**

The team reviewed the district priorities for 2022-2023. These priorities were established by the District Leadership Team using a data driven decision making framework. The committee did not have any additional questions regarding the district priorities.

**III. Additional comments before adjourning**

Mr. Crum posed questions regarding the purchase of Edulastic. The district opted to shift from Illuminate to Edulastic due to user friendliness and cost. The team also discussed what the district is doing to support at risk students who might be living in undesirable conditions. Through partnership with the Washington County Sheriff Department (Ellie Reynolds) and the district Truancy Officer (Kathy Neehouse) Warren is able to provide support as deemed necessary by the team.
