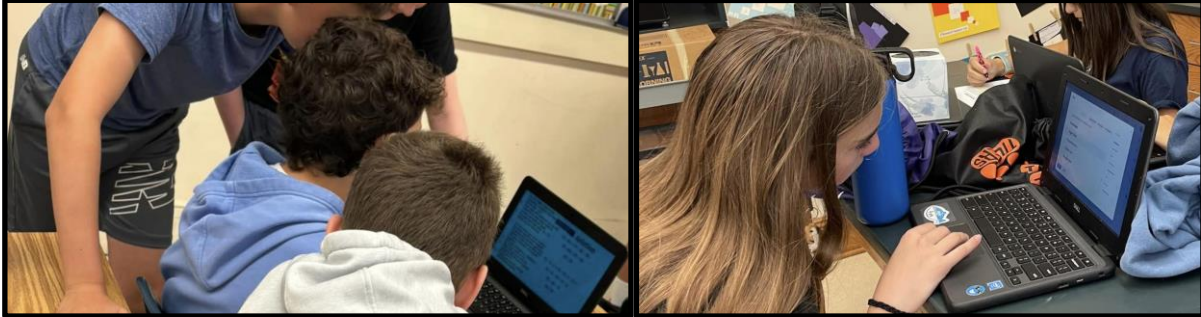


# Chromebooks at TUFSD

## What to know!



Chromebooks are distributed each fall and must be returned at the end of the school year or upon leaving the district.

### **Damage, Loss, and Theft:**

- Immediate reporting is required for any damage, loss, or theft. Students can report damage and incidents to the circulation desk in the MS/HS library.
- Accidental damage fines range from **\$40 to \$50**, increasing with each incident. After two incidents, students may lose privileges and face disciplinary action. Intentional damage incurs high-level fines covering all replacement or repair costs.
- Loss of a Chromebook can cost as much as **\$249** (depending on the replacement cost at the time).
- Theft must be reported to the administration and the Eastchester Police Department at no cost to the student.

### **General Care and Maintenance:**

- Students are responsible for keeping Chromebooks in good working condition and charged daily.
- Parents may wish to carry personal insurance for theft, loss, or damage not covered by the district.

### **Policy Adherence:**

- Students must follow all TUFSD policies, including the Responsible Use Policy.
- Unauthorized applications and changes to device settings are prohibited and monitored.
