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ELECTION GUIDELINES

FOR THE CATEGORY OF ADULT WITH A DISABILITY

Eligibility

Per CA Education Code, section 56192, members elected for these positions must be adults with disabilities. Participants must be over the age of 18 who reside in the LAUSD SELPA boundaries and are not enrolled in high school. To determine eligibility, participants should be prepared to share the nature of their disability to the extent that they feel comfortable. Specific information shared regarding disabilities will be kept confidential and used solely for determining eligibility to participate in the election. According to the Americans with Disabilities Act, a person with a disability is someone who:

- 1) has a physical or mental impairment that **substantially limits one or more major life activities**,
- 2) has a history or record of such an impairment
- 3) is perceived by others as having such an impairment.

Major life activities are eating, sleeping, speaking, and breathing; walking, standing, lifting, and bending; thinking and concentrating; seeing and hearing; working, learning, and communicating; issues with circulation, reproduction, and functional issues with individual organs.

Voting Process

In accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code, section 56191, prospective members in the "Adult with a Disability" category will be elected by their peers. Please be aware that eligible participants who join the meeting after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to join on time.
