Most members are parents or guardians of children with disabilities. The CAC serves in an advisory role to the SELPA director, the Board of Education, and the Superintendent’s cabinet. Get involved! ELECTION GUIDELINES

FOR THE CATEGORIES OF REPRESENTATIVE OF A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE AGENCY AND COMMUNITY MEMBER (non-parent)

Eligibility

- The **Representative of a Public or Private Agency** must be employed by a public or private agency that serves the needs of individuals with exceptional needs within the LAUSD SELPA boundaries.
- The **Community Member (non-parent)** is a person concerned with the needs of individuals with exceptional needs and must reside within the boundaries of the LAUSD SELPA.

Voting Process

Please be aware that eligible participants who join the meeting after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to join on time.

In accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code, section 56191:

- Prospective members in the "Representative of a Public or Private Agency" category will be elected by their peers.
- Prospective members in the "Community Member (non-parent)" category will be elected by their peers.
