GUIDELINES FOR MID-YEAR DISTRICTWIDE ELECTIONS TO FILL VACANCIES FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN OF GENERAL EDUCATION STUDENTS

Eligibility

Must be a parent/guardian of a student in General Education that attends a school covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Prospective members in the “Parent/Guardian of General Education Student” category will be selected by their peers in accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code 56191.

Length of Term

The representative and alternate vacancies in the Parent of General Education Student category are for terms ending in June of 2026.
