ELECTION GUIDELINES **FOR GENERAL EDUCATION TEACHER AND OTHER SCHOOL PERSONNEL CATEGORIES**

Eligibility

Must be a General Education Teacher or Other School Personnel (non-teacher) at a school covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Please be aware that eligible participants who arrive or join after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.

In accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code, section 56191:

- Prospective members in the “General Education Teacher” category will be elected by their peers.
- Prospective members in the “Other School Personnel” category will be elected by their peers.
