ELECTION GUIDELINES

FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN OF STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY OR WITH A 504 PLAN ATTENDING A SCHOOL IN REGION EAST

Eligibility

Must be a parent/guardian of a student with a disability or with a 504 Plan that attends a school in Region East covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Prospective members in the “Parent/Guardian of Student with Exceptional Needs” category will be elected by their peers in accordance with the Los Angeles Unified School District SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code, section 56191. Please note that eligible parents (parents of students with an IEP or a 504 Plan) who arrive or join after the review of the operating norms and code of conduct listed on the agenda will not be permitted to vote, nominate, or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.

Length of Term

If elected and appointed, the length of term for representatives is 2 years. Term commitment will span 2 school years (2026–2028).
