ELECTION GUIDELINES **FOR THE CATEGORY OF STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY**

Eligibility

Must be a student with an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or with a 504 Plan at a school covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Prospective members in the “Student with Exceptional Needs” category will be elected by their peers in accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code, section 56191. Please be aware that eligible participants who arrive or join after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.
