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ELECTION GUIDELINES

Eligibility

Prospective candidates must meet eligibility criteria, which include one of the following: they must provide evidence that they live, work, or have a child enrolled in a school covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan. This will be based on the category they are interested in. Visit lausd.org/CAC for the flyers with eligibility details per category.

Voting Process

Prospective members in each category will be elected by their peers in accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code section 56191. Please be aware that eligible participants who arrive or join after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.
