ELECTION GUIDELINES

FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN OF STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY OR WITH A 504 PLAN ATTENDING A SCHOOL IN REGION NORTH

Eligibility

Must be a parent/guardian of a student with a disability or with a 504 Plan that attends a school in Region North covered by the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan.

Voting Process

Prospective members in the “Parent/Guardian of Student with Exceptional Needs” category will be elected by their peers in accordance with the LAUSD SELPA Local Plan and California Education Code section 56191. Please be aware that eligible parents (parents of students with an IEP or with a 504 Plan) who arrive or join after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.

Length of Term
