ELECTION GUIDELINES

FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN OF STUDENT IN THE GENERAL EDUCATION PROGRAM

Please be aware that eligible parents (parents of students in the General Education Program) who arrive or join after a review of the operating norms and code of conduct on the agenda will no longer be seated to vote, nominate or be nominated. Please plan to arrive or join on time.
