Safe & Welcoming Environment: Emergency Preparedness

At the Office of Parent & Community Services we hold an inventory of emergency equipment in the case that we experience a natural disaster during any committee meetings or workshops. For today's report I wanted to highlight key emergency exits located in the main auditorium and general building. In addition to directing your attention to emergency exits be mindful of your behavior if an earthquake impacts our school district. In the case of an earthquake membership is asked to duck and cover under your table. The public is asked to do the same by your seats or a doorway closest to you. There are not artifacts around the public that may fall directly on you. Do not walk out until shaking has ended. In case of a fire or other emergency notify a PCS staff member immediately and exit using one of the locations included in our evacuation map. For questions please contact a PCS administrator.
