FAMILY MONEY FUN: GAMES AND SMART CHOICES

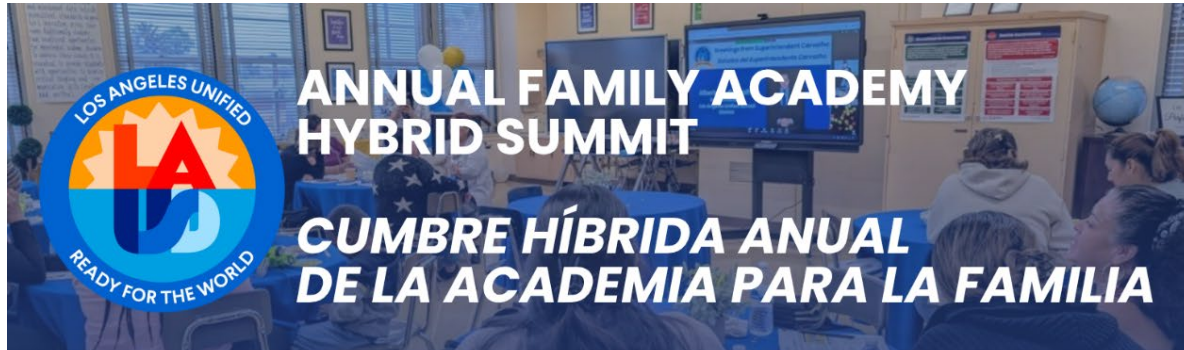
