Any person, organization, or public agency may mail, fax, or email a written complaint to the Office of Student Civil Rights.

Response Time

Results are provided in a written investigation report within 60 days of the Office of Student Civil Rights (OSCR) receiving the UCP complaint. A response that includes a resolution will be provided within 45 days of the OSCR's receipt of a Williams Complaint.

Uniform Complaint Procedure (UCP)

Concerns about student civil rights, alleging violations of federal or state laws or regulations, including unlawful discrimination, harassment, intimidation, or bullying against any protected group fall under the UCP. These are pursuant to procedures in §§4600-4671 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).

Williams Complaint

Concerns about textbooks and instructional materials, facility conditions and teacher vacancies or misassignments fall under the Williams Complaint. These are pursuant to procedures in §§4680-4694 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations (CCR).
