



## CAC CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT

### MARCH 21, 2018

- Attended Central Committee meeting with Interim Superintendent Vivian Ekchian. Detailed information was given concerning graduation (A\_G) preparation rates for high school (9-12) students with subgroup break downs and SBAC testing data. Superintendent Ekchian mentioned that a school would be named after Dr. Michelle King and she invited members to the March 13 Board Meeting where a report about improving academic achievement of African American students will be presented. March 13 is a strategic date as it's before right budget priorities and determinations are discussed and formed.
- Attended the AEA Advisory for African American Students. The plan that would be presented to the Board of Education was discussed. It is a multi-facet plan that includes increasing student achievement and feeling of acceptance, outreach and partnering with parents of African American students, and culturally and linguistically yearly trainings for all LAUSD staff. This report will be presented on March 13 to the Board of Education. Superintendent Ekchian confirmed that Girls Academic and Leadership Academy (GALA) would be named for Dr. Michelle King and she mentioned that a school would be named for Dr. George McKenna. Attendees included Dr. McKenna, Superintendent Ekchian, Dr. Frances Gipson, BCCLA, Superintendent Cheryl Hildreth, and Superintendent Christopher Downing and other parents and LAUSD staff.
