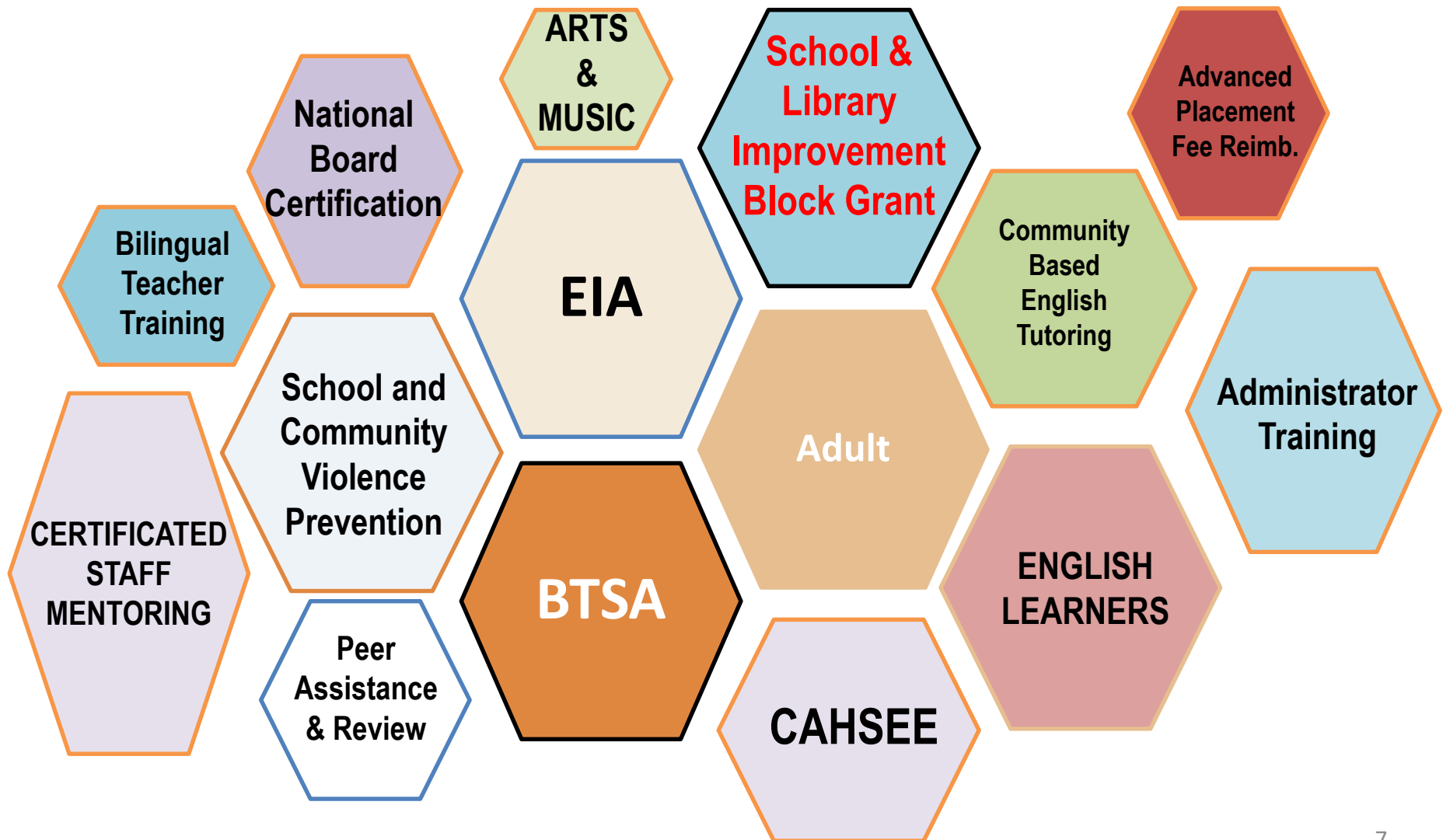
What is LCFF?

- Local Control Funding Formula - July 2013
- Legislation that significantly changes the state's method of distributing funds to school districts.

How did LCFF impact categorical programs?

- Over 60 categorical programs were combined under LCFF, including EIA-LEP.
