The decision to move forward with the motion on the floor as Diana Guillen has not officially taken the role of Chairperson because election of officers has not been completed.

A Roll Call vote was taken at 5:17 p.m. on the motion to extend the meeting for one (1) hour. The following members were not in the room at the time their names were called:
