 - The ASP, when combined with the Annual Budget Plan (ABP) and the Personnel Data Report, provides a profile of the special education and related services provided by a SELPA

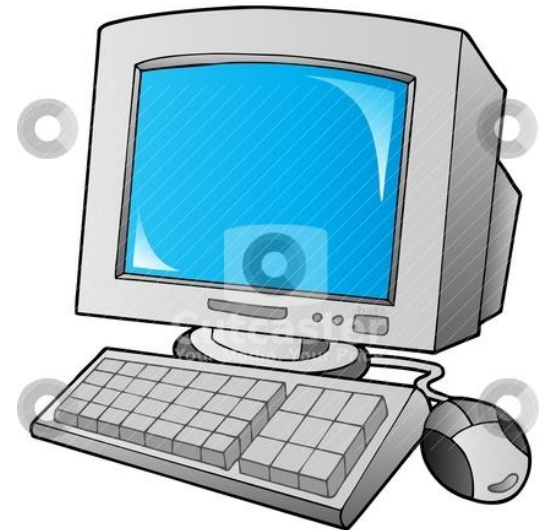

CASEMIS

- ◉ A comprehensive data reporting and retrieval system required by CDE.
- ◉ Used to monitor special education programs in the State on a continuous basis
- ◉ To evaluate the effectiveness of special education programs in California
- ◉ SELPA CASEMIS reports are due to the CDE in early ***December***.
- ◉ In January SELPAs have the opportunity to clear up any data error
- ◉ Final report at the end of January
