### **PAC Business Meeting #3 – December 11, 2025**

We finally have a way for parents from all across the district can communicate with the Executive Board, and in turn, the whole of the committee.

On December 1<sup>st</sup>, a small number of PAC members, along with members of the CAC and DELAC, participated in the District's Budget Priorities and Fiscal Stabilization Plan hybrid meeting. To say the presentation was underwhelming is a gross understatement. Below are some of the lowlights from that meeting:

- Over the last 10 years enrollment has decreased by approximately 26.5%;
- No plans were shared on how to reverse this trend;
- The projected budget shortfall is \$1.6B, which could be worse as it does not include potential employee compensation increases;
- The deficit will consume all of the current cash reserves;
- No plans were shared on how to reverse this trend;
- The presenter could not answer any specific questions and the presentation was over generalized;
- I, along with the CAC Chairperson formally requested a stand-alone meeting for our respective committees to discuss, in depth, the District's budget shortfall and what measures are being taken to protect our students;

Included with my report, are the slides that were presented. I strongly, strongly encourage all of the members to review these slides and formulate any questions that you have, so that when we have our meeting, we can provide these questions ahead of time. We deserve to get real, substantive answers!
