District Updates

- There is a Special Local School Funding Election on June 4, 2019. The Los Angeles School District Board of Education voted unanimously to place **Measure EE**, a 16 cent per square foot parcel tax, on the ballot in a special local school funding election. Measure EE will provide additional locally controlled school funding.
- Board District 5 has a new Board member. Board Member Jackie Goldberg was sworn in on Tuesday, May 21, 2019. We congratulate Ms. Goldberg and look forward to having her visit our various committee meetings and or activities.
- Congratulations to Dr. Vivian Ekhian for being selected as the new Superintendent for Glendale Unified. We wish her a lot of luck and thank her for her continued support of our parents and PCS.

Committee Update

We currently have 50 members in the PAC. This week we sent 3 termination letters and 10 warning letters. The Bylaws committee may want to review the language in the bylaws and see if there is a way to have PAC members submit a temporary leave in case there are family emergencies or personal situations.
