**WHO**

All K-12 students can get free, 1-to-1 homework help in all academic subjects and writing support.

Tutors are available in multiple languages.

Virtual tutors provide literacy and math support in small groups of 3-5 students. Students in all schools who are in need of this support will be eligible to participate via parent choice.

Tutors are on site at priority schools to provide in-person support in literacy and/or math to students in small groups or pairs.

Virtual tutors provide literacy and math support in small groups of 3-5 students. Students at all schools who are in need of this support will be invited to participate.

Los Angeles Unified teachers provide in-person academic intervention lessons.
