TITLE VI AMERICAN INDIAN PARENT COMMITTEE

Any parent with a student enrolled in the Title VI Program is eligible to be a committee member. The parent committee advises, approves, and signs off on programs allocated for the American Indian Education Program within the yearly grant.

COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Meets monthly during the school year to review programs and services for students with special needs and provide feedback on the District's Special Education Local Plan Area (SELPA) Local Plan.

DISTRICT ENGLISH LEARNER ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Meets monthly during the school year to review and provide advice on the programs and services for English Learner students described in two District plans.

PARENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Meets monthly during the school year to review and provide input on the programs and services for all students in the District's Local Control and Accountability Plan.
