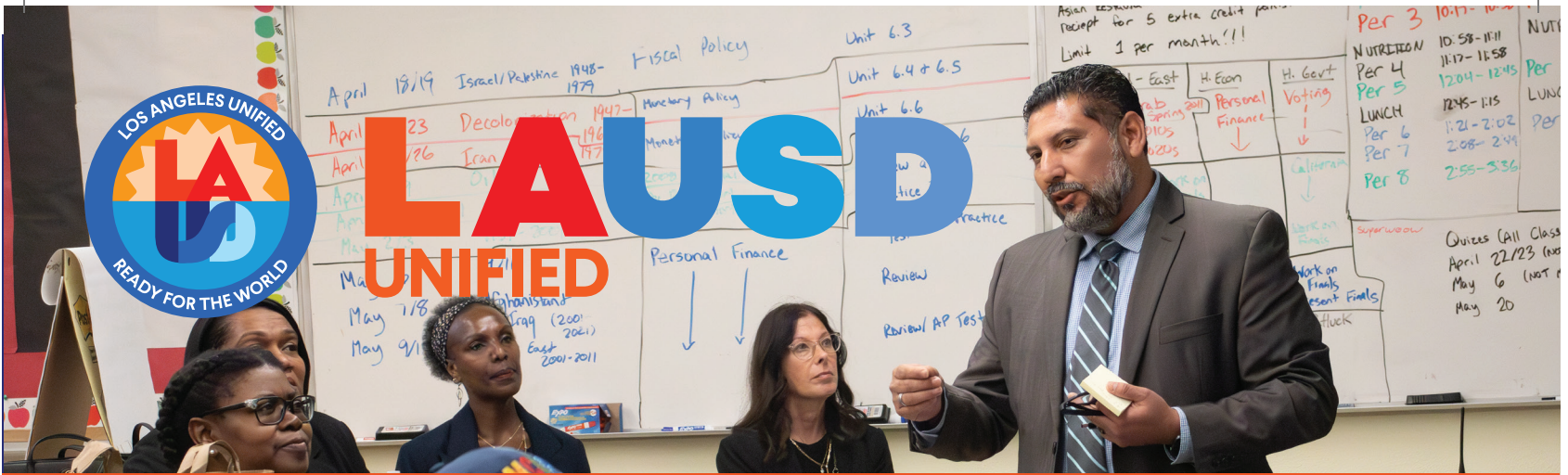

### **SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL (SSC)**

### **ENGLISH LEARNER ADVISORY COMMITTEE (ELAC)**

Schools with 21 or more English Learners must form a committee that focuses on their academic needs. As a member, you will learn about EL student needs and advocate for their success.

### **ATTEND FAMILY ACADEMY WORKSHOPS**

School and District offices offer a variety of workshops to provide learning centered on student achievement and family wrap-around services.

### **ATTEND REGIONAL AND DISTRICT EVENTS**

### **VISUALIZE SUCCESS**

Regularly assess the effectiveness of your child's academic growth and meet with school staff as needed to ensure your child is "Ready for the World."
