


Current Process

- Upon Incarceration the Los Angeles County Sherriff's Department Determines:
 - When/Where the individual was last enrolled
 - If they were receiving special education services
 - If they wish to continue to receive services
 - With which agency they want to continue services
 - Then, communicates with LAUSD if they wish to receive services through LAUSD




If LAUSD Is Selected

- Services per the IEP is implemented to the maximum extent possible at the location of incarceration
 - A new IEP is conducted to align services
 - Progress monitoring is conducted
- 



Trends

- Many incarcerated youth do not disclose their disability status
 - LA County Sheriff Department has now partnered with charter schools that are now housed at the jails
 - A State level committee was formed between school districts, the California Department of Education, and law enforcement agencies to address issues.
