LOCAL CONTROL FUNDING FORMULA CALIFORNIA EDUCATION CODE

Section 52063

- Develop a Parent Advisory Committee made up of the parents or guardians of **at least one** of three targeted student subgroups identified under the Local Control Funding Formula to *provide advice* to the Governing Board about the LCAP
- Develop a District English Learner Advisory Committee to provide advice to the Governing Board about the LCAP

Section 52062

- Present the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) to the Parent Advisory Committee for *review and comment*, with the Superintendent responding to committee comments in writing
- Present the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) to the District English Learner Advisory Committee for *review and comment*, with the Superintendent responding to committee comments in writing

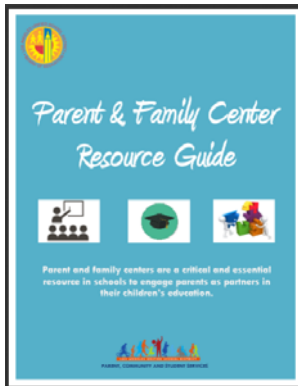

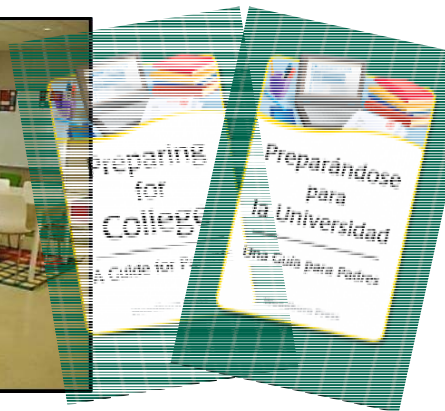
